Detectives Seek Fatal Hit and Run Suspect

(February 10, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are looking for a suspect that left the scene of a fatal collision Friday night.

On February 9, 2024, at about 8:00 p.m., officers with the Phoenix Police Department were called to a pedestrian involved collision at 26th Street and Oak Street. When officers got to the scene, they found a woman suffering serious injuries. The woman was taken to the hospital where she did not survive from her injuries.

Detectives responded to the scene and took over the investigation. It was learned that the driver of an SUV was going east on Oak Street when it hit the woman crossing outside a cross walk. The suspects SUV then left the area without attempting to help the victim. Detectives are asking for the communities help in identifying the vehicle and or driver of this incident. Anyone with information is encouraged to call into Silent Witness where they will be eligible for a cash reward. All calls into Silent Witness will remain anonymous.
