### **One Killed One Hospitalized After Shooting in Ahwatukee**

(July 12, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives search for the suspect of a violent shooting that left one victim dead and one injured, at an Ahwatukee apartment complex early Friday morning.

Just after 2:00 a.m., officers responded to a shooting call at an apartment complex located at 11025 South 51<sup>st</sup> Street. When officers got to the scene, they contacted several witnesses and detained individuals believed to be involved in the shooting. Two adult male victims were also located in the apartment swimming pool area and were treated for gunshot wounds. Both victims were taken to the hospital for care, with one being released with non-life-threatening injuries. The second victim identified as 19-year-old Kashmit Vaughn was not able to survive his injuries and died at the hospital.

Detectives responded to the scene and took over the investigation. Initial information was learned that two groups of people were in a verbal argument inside the fenced area of the apartment swimming pool area where the shooting took place. No arrests have been made at this time. Detectives encourage anyone with information to call Silent Witness where videos and pictures can be uploaded anonymously. 480-WITNESS, 480-TESTIGO.
