## TRANSIT ADVERTISING STANDARDS

## Effective January 20, 2023

- A. It is the intent of the City that all transit advertising panels on city buses and on transit furniture are non-public forums and are to be available only to advertising for: proposing commercial transactions, promoting tourism, or informing the public about City-provided or transit-specific services and programs. It is not the intent of the City to allow advertising of non-commercial speech. The City's primary purpose for the transit advertising panel is generating revenue.
- B. Other than advertising for informing the public about City-provided and transit-specific services and programs, no advertising will be accepted for use on any city bus or transit furniture that fails to comply with the following standards:
  - 1. The subject matter of and the speech in the advertisement must be limited to a proposed commercial transaction or promotion of tourism. All messaging within the advertisement must be limited to words, symbols, or depictions that directly propose a commercial transaction or promote tourism.
    - a. A proposed commercial transaction advertisement must solicit an exchange of property, goods, or services with intended customers that will necessarily result in something of economic value to the advertiser.
    - b. A promotion of tourism advertisement must solicit travel to and tourism of a geographical area with the intent to derive commercial revenue from visitors who travel to the area and purchase goods or services.

## 2. The advertising may not:

- a. Be false, misleading, or deceptive.
- b. Relate to an activity or product that is prohibited under applicable federal, state, or local laws and regulations.
- c. Advertise or depict, by language or graphics, violence or anti-social behavior.

- d. Advertise or depict language, gestures, conduct, or graphical representations that are obscene, pornographic, vulgar, profane, or scatological.
- e. Depict a *nude* or *seminude* person, as those terms are defined in Section 11-811, Arizona Revised Statutes, or the exposed buttocks of any person.
- f. Depict, relate to, or reference a website or other medium that relates to *specified sexual activities* or *specified anatomical areas* as those terms are defined in Section 11-811, Arizona Revised Statutes.
- g. Advertise or depict the use of tobacco, marijuana, or smoking/vaping products, whether or not the product is advertised or depicted in a non-smoking form.
- h. Advertise or depict the use of *spirituous liquor* as that term is defined in Section 4-101, Arizona Revised Statutes:
  - i. On the exterior or interior of Phoenix Neighborhood Circulator vehicles.
  - ii. On the interior of any transit vehicle.
  - iii. On transit furniture that is located less than 600 feet from a church or similar structure of worship, or school building.
