







Growing up, Zero enjoyed helping the workers sort through recyclable materials.

PLASTIC BAGS are not recyclable in your household recycle container. Please bring them back to a retail or grocery store for recycling.


The three R's of Phoenix Recycling are **REDUCE**, **REUSE** and **RECYCLE**.

When recycling at home, leave items **LOOSE** and not **BAGGED** in the recycle container.







