

Davis-Bacon Act of 1931



Pennsylvania Senator James John Davis 1873-1947

- Federal construction (prime) contracts > \$2000
- New Construction
- Alteration
- Remodeling



New York Representative, Robert Bacon 1884-1938



Davis-Bacon Act

- Applies to all laborers and mechanics
- Requires payment of prevailing wages
- Requires weekly payment of wages









New York Senator Royal S. Copeland 1868-1938

Copeland Anti-Kickback Act of 1934

- Criminalizes "Kick-backs"
- Requires Payroll
 Certification
- Monitors Deductions



Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (CWHSSA)

- Enacted 1962
- Overtime
- \$100,000 Threshold
- Liquidated damages






