



19th Avenue & Cave Creek Wash Pedestrian Trail

Project #ST87600073

Project Overview

The Cave Creek Wash Trail is part of the City of Phoenix trail system. This 18-mile-long recreational trail along the Cave Creek wash currently ends on the east side of 19th Avenue south of Greenway Road, and begins again south of the Cave Creek Municipal Golf Course driveway.

The purpose of this project is to connect the approximately 2,000-foot gap in the Cave Creek Wash Trail on the west side of 19th Avenue, providing better connectivity to the regional Sun Circle Trail, a 10-foot wide trail that is ultimately planned to be a 140-mile-long multi-use path, which is part of the Maricopa County Regional Trail System.

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department in partnership with City of Phoenix Parks and Recreation Department has contracted with TALIS Corp to construct this new portion of the Cave Creek Wash Trail.

This new asphalt trail will cross the Cave Creek Municipal Golf Course driveway, and proceed east to 19th Avenue, then north adjacent to 19th Avenue to the Cave Creek Wash Trail alignment.

Existing pedestrian lighting will be enhanced with new light poles and luminaries.

Project Schedule

Construction of the new trail is anticipated to begin late October 2013. Overall construction is projected to last through January 2014. Traffic restrictions are not anticipated with the exception of some minor curb lane restrictions when work is being performed immediately adjacent to 19th Avenue.
