Construction Starting

3rd Avenue:

On Thursday, August 6, 2020, construction activities will begin at the intersection of **3rd Avenue and Culver Street**, and will include:

- Removal and replacement of existing concrete ramps, curb, gutter, and sidewalks.
- Construction of new catch basin on the northeast corner, and new storm drain pipe crossing 3rd Avenue to the northwest corner.
- New median island north of Culver Street.
- New landscape on the northwest and southwest sides of 3rd Avenue including trees, agave, yucca, and yellow lantana.
- Restoration of existing decomposed granite in landscape areas.
- Installation of concrete pavers on ramps, and in the new median island north of Culver Street.

What to Expect:


- Work hours will generally be Monday - Friday 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Some weekend work may occur.
- Traffic restrictions will be in place including lane closures and turn restrictions.
- Alternate routes are encouraged whenever possible.
