

PROJECT UPDATE – November 2023

45th Avenue from Grand Canal to Camelback Road

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department appreciates the community's participation and thoughtful input while it considered proposed changes to the section of 45th Avenue from the Grand Canal to Camelback Road.

In October 2022, the department shared options to update parking and bikes lanes with the community through a pre-recorded presentation and encouraged feedback via an online survey. The survey was available from October 3 to 23, 2022, and was reopened to gather additional input from February 8 to March 31, 2023.

The input gathered from that outreach effort and engineering judgment were taken into consideration as department staff selected the final design.

PROJECT DETAILS

- The proposed update included three options each for two segments of the corridor.
Segment 1: Grand Canal to Indian School Road
Segment 2: Indian School Road to Camelback Road

DECISION

- The decision is to add continuous buffered bike lanes. Parking will be removed from the east side of the street from the Grand Canal to Indian School Road (Segment 1), and all parking will be removed from Indian School Road to Camelback Road (Segment 2).

WHAT'S NEXT

- The new lane configuration is scheduled to be striped during winter 2023.
