Construction Starting

5th Avenue:

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department has begun the 3rd and 5th Avenues Improvement Project. On May 27, construction activities will begin on the northeast and northwest corners of 5th Avenue and Washington Street, and will include:

- Removal and replacement of existing concrete ramps, curb, gutter, sidewalks, driveways, catch basins and connector pipes.
- Installation of two new streetlights.
- Placement of decomposed granite on the northeast corner.

What to Expect:

- Work hours will generally be Monday - Friday 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Some weekend work may occur.
- Traffic restrictions will be in place including lane closures.
- Alternate routes are encouraged whenever possible.
