

PROJECT UPDATE – MAY 2022

Fillmore from Central Avenue to 7th Street

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department appreciates the community's participation and thoughtful input while it considered proposed changes to the section of Fillmore Street from Central Avenue to 7th Street.

In March 2022, the department sent out a digital project update ([also available on the project website](#)) informing the public of the final design for the section of 1st Street to 7th Street. The March update informed the community that bike lanes with vertical delineators will be added along that section, and promised an additional update related to the Central Avenue to 1st Street section. That is the purpose of this notification.

City staff used stakeholder input gathered during various outreach efforts and engineering judgment to select the final design.

PROJECT DETAILS

- There were three options presented for Fillmore Street from Central Avenue to 1st Street. Option A was to make no changes, while option B and C were to include bike lanes. Based on community feedback, the department re-evaluated the two bike lane options.

DECISION

- Bike lanes with vertical delineators will be installed on the north and south sides of Fillmore Street from Central Avenue to 1st Street and all on-street parking will be removed.
