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

Mobility Area

Study Area

T2050 Mobility Assessment Study Area 2, Indian School-Grand Neighborhoods, is a 0.4 square mile area bounded by 23rd Avenue on the west, 18th Avenue on the east, Turney Avenue on the north, and Clarendon Avenue on the south.

Current Conditions

There are currently bus routes within the study area along Indian School Road and19th Avenue. 23rd Avenue has been identified as a bikeway in the City of Phoenix Master Bike Plan. Currently, there are existing sidewalk gaps and bike lane gaps along 23rd Avenue. In addition to gaps in the sidewalk, there are many locations where existing curb ramps and driveways do not meet current standards. Recently the pedestrian bridge over the Grand Canal south of Indian School Road has been closed. This bridge is an important part of the local mobility network and should be reopened.

Purpose and Need

Many of the people living within the study area do not own a vehicle making them mobility dependent. The study will identify areas of improvement for all users. Initial engagement with the public, has brought to light many safety concerns. Their concerns include:

- Heavy afternoon rush hour traffic traveling northbound on 23rd Avenue south of Indian School Road and excessive vehicle speeds on 23rd Avenue, and 22nd Avenue
- Vehicles exiting the business onto Indian School Road at the northeast corner of 23rd Avenue and Indian School Road adjacent to the traffic signal causes conflict between turning vehicles and pedestrians crossing Indian School Road
- Difficulties for users with disabilities crossing Indian School Road at 23rd Avenue due to placement of pedestrian push buttons in relation to curb ramps
- No crosswalks on 23rd Avenue north of Indian School Road
- Improved street lighting at various locations throughout the study area

Other areas identified for improvement include gaps in the sidewalk system and bike lanes on 23rd Avenue, curb ramps, driveways, and pedestrian push buttons locations at





23rd Avenue and 19th Avenue intersections with Indian School Road that do not meet current standards.



Draft Recommendations

ADA Improvement projects

Driveway and curb ramp projects are listed in Table 2 - ADA Improvements. The individual projects have been divided into specific areas or districts. The projects are shown on Map 2 – Sidewalk/Curb Ramp Improvements. Improvements, to meet current standards include reconstruction of curb ramps and driveways where necessary. In some locations, improvements will require relocation of existing utility poles to remove barriers to pedestrians with mobility disabilities.

Bicycle Improvements projects

The Bicycle Improvement project is listed in Table 3 - Bicycle Improvements. The individual bicycle improvement project has been specified on 23rd Avenue from Indian School Road south, to the pedestrian bridge over the canal.

Bicycle improvements include installation of new bike lane striping, and signage.

Sidewalk improvement projects

Sidewalk improvement projects are listed in Table 4 - Sidewalk Improvements. The individual sidewalk projects have been divided into specific areas or districts. Sidewalk improvements shall include the installation of new sidewalk to eliminate gaps in the existing sidewalk system, and sidewalk reconstruction to meet current standards.

Safety improvements

The safety improvement is listed in Table 6 – Intersection Improvements. Stakeholder has identified the need for traffic calming features on 22nd Avenue to slow traffic speeds.





Improvements include the installation of speed tables on 22nd Avenue between Fairmount Avenue and Indian School Road.

Street Light Improvements

No separate street lighting projects have been identified. Street light improvements are identified as part of the 23rd Avenue and Indian School Road Intersection improvements. Improvements shall include installation of new street light poles and appurtenances to enhance lighting at the intersection.

Trees / Shade

Proposed improvements in the study area do not include separate projects to provide trees for shade. Trees plantings have been included in the sidewalk improvement project on 23rd Avenue between Osborn Road and Fairmount Avenue.

<u>Transit</u>

Bus stops within the study area were found to be in accordance with current standards and not in need of sidewalk improvements, therefore no proposed transit stop improvements were identified in the study. However, various bus stops within the study area are missing benches and/or shelters. The installation of shelters and benches will be funded as part of other transit improvement projects.

Intersection Improvements

Intersection improvements are listed in Table 6 – Intersection Improvements. Improvements include:





- Relocate pedestrian push buttons, reconstruct curb ramps and restripe • crosswalks at the corners of 19th Avenue and Indian School Road intersection
- Relocate pedestrian push buttons, reconstruct curb ramps and restripe crosswalks at the corners of 23rd Avenue and Indian School Road intersection
- Control the access onto Indian School Road by eliminating the business exit only driveway, located at the northeast corner of 23rd Avenue and Indian School Road




Photo 8 - Indian School Rd, West of 19th Ave, Looking East

Project Description

- The project will eliminate the existing business driveway exit at the northeast
- corner of the intersection. The improvements will include new pavement, curb and gutter, sidewalk and street lights.

- The removing the business driveway will eliminate conflicts between exiting vehicles and pedestrians crossing at the intersection.



Project Description

- The project will include the installation of speed tables on 22nd Avenue between Fairmount Avenue and Indian School Road.
- The project will include asphalt pavement improvements and new signage.

Project Benefits





- The proposed traffic calming improvements will slow traffic speeds thorough the area to enhance safety for the pedestrians and bicyclists.
- Enhance signage at the Fairmount Avenue and 22nd Avenue intersection to eliminate motorists running the stop signs.
