



## Neighborhood Notification: Safety Improvements to Bicycle Lanes 91st Avenue from Illini Street to Lower Buckeye Road

As part of the Street Transportation Department's core mission, we strive to improve the City's roadways to create a safe and efficient transportation network. Our ongoing pavement maintenance program provides opportunities to change the current traffic lane striping to improve safety for people who walk, drive, ride bicycles and use transit.

### About the Project

**Where:** 91st Avenue from Illini Street to Lower Buckeye Road.

**What:** Where there is enough space on the roadway, a buffer will be added to the existing bicycle lanes. The number of travel lanes will remain the same. Parking availability/restrictions and the number of travel lanes will remain the same.

**When:** 91st Ave. from Illini St. to Lower Buckeye Rd. is scheduled for pavement maintenance (new asphalt) in spring/summer 2020 and will be ready for traffic lane striping improvements. Pavement maintenance work is subject to change. Traffic lane striping will begin shortly after the pavement work is complete. Before the pavement work begins, the properties located directly next to the roadway where the work will be taking place will be notified.

**Why:** The buffer between the vehicle lanes and bicycle lanes adds space between people driving vehicles and people walking or biking for increased protection from vehicles. Additionally, the slight narrowing of the lane widths to accommodate the buffers will help to guide and slow traffic.
