



Neighborhood Notification: Safety Improvements to Bicycle Lanes on Roeser Road from 7th Ave to Central Ave

As part of the Street Transportation Department's core mission, we strive to improve the City's roadways to create a safe and efficient transportation network.

Our ongoing pavement maintenance program provides opportunities to change the current traffic lane striping to improve safety for people who walk, drive, ride bicycles and use transit.

About the Project

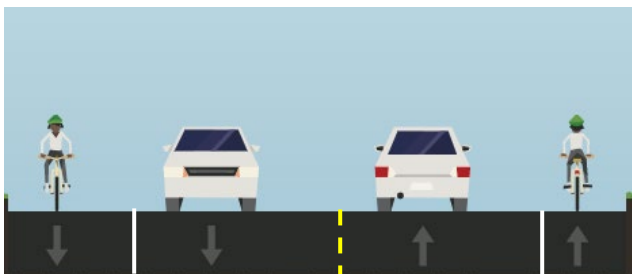
Where: Roeser Road from 7th Avenue to Central Avenue

What: Where there is enough space on the roadway, a buffer will be added to the existing bicycle lanes. The number of travel lanes will remain the same. This project does not remove or add parking.

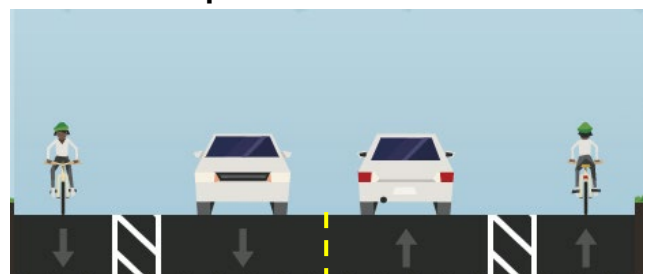
When: Pavement maintenance (new asphalt) is scheduled for spring 2020 and traffic lane improvements will happen shortly after.

Why: The buffer between the vehicle lanes and bicycle lanes adds space between people driving vehicles and people walking or biking for increased protection from vehicles, improved safety and added comfort. Additionally, the slight narrowing of the lane widths to accommodate the buffers will help to guide and slow traffic. This project also connects to nearby bicycle lanes.
