

Update: 16th Street, Jefferson Street to Roosevelt Street Proposed Bike Lane Changes

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department greatly appreciates the responses we received from the community through the public outreach process regarding the proposed lane changes on 16th Street from Adams Street to Roosevelt Street. Thank you so much to those who participated in our virtual meeting and provided input via the digital survey!

The Street Transportation Department will be moving forward with the proposed lane changes; however, because of the fire damage requiring the 7th Street Bridge over the Salt River to remain closed, the paving and striping have been delayed.

This location will receive an asphalt mill and overlay treatment as part of the [Accelerated Pavement Maintenance Program](#). The asphalt treatment is tentatively scheduled for fall 2021 depending on the bridge reconstruction and reopening.

After the paving work is complete, the proposed lane changes will be striped as show below.



This striping layout will vary slightly near the the intersections.
