

METRO is fun and exciting but you also need to pay attention around the light rail. Before we take the METRO to the party we should learn some of the safety rules.



METRO SAFETY RULES

- Stop, Listen, Look left, right and left again and listen around METRO tracks. METRO trains are quiet.
- Cross only in a crosswalk and obey the pedestrian signals.
- Look left, right and left again before crossing the tracks.
- Never skateboard, roller blade or ride your bike on the tracks or on the station platform.
- · Do not place anything on the tracks.
- Always let your parents or an adult know where you are going.
- Walk your bikes in the crosswalks. Never stop or park your bike on METRO tracks.
- Obey the traffic signals and signs. Cross only on the WALK signal.
- · Don't walk on or stand near the tracks.
- When waiting in the train platform, stand behind the black line and the bumps, far away from the edge of the platform.

Please remember these safety rules while you are at the station or near the tracks.
