



Executive Summary

The Sonoran Boulevard has been planned and designated as a City of Phoenix arterial roadway since 1987. This roadway is an important east-west alignment between Interstate 17 and northeast Phoenix.

Project includes:

- Seven miles of new arterial roadway extending Dove Valley Road from 15th Avenue to Cave Creek Road with portions traversing the Sonoran Preserve
- Five miles of shared-use path that weaves through the desert up to a quarter mile from the roadway
- Three bridges with artistic features, and balconies with seating and shade
- Renaming the existing Dove Valley Road to “Sonoran Boulevard”

Special Amenities include:

- Raised median islands and landscaping that will maintain the visual aspect of the preserve by blending nature into the roadway design
- Box culverts that allow for natural drainage as well as accommodate crossing areas for wildlife, equestrians, and hikers
