Project Overview:

The city of Phoenix Street Transportation Department is hosting an open house meeting to share the latest on the design plans for this project and discuss construction. Project design plans are 60 percent complete and construction is projected to start spring/summer 2019.

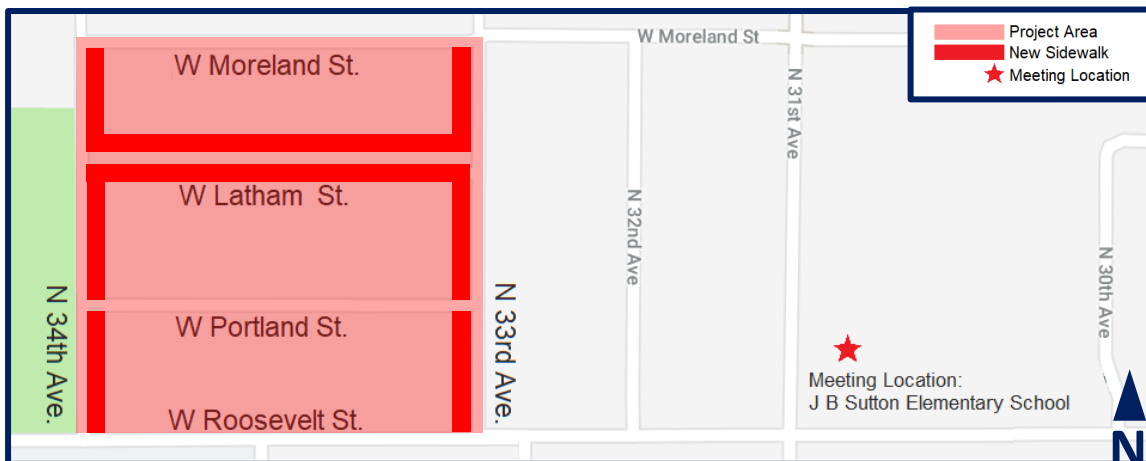
Project Details:

This project is aimed at improving pedestrian mobility and safety.

Project modifications include:

- New sidewalks, with wheel chair accessible curb ramps, on 33rd and 34th avenues between Roosevelt and Moreland streets; and Latham Street between 34th and 33rd avenues.
- Upgrading existing street lights to feature LED lights.
- Widening 33rd Avenue from Roosevelt to Moreland streets to accommodate for the new curb, gutter and sidewalk.
- Tiling of the existing open irrigation ditch between Latham and Moreland streets.
