



Slug Discharge Written Notification

40 CFR 403.8(f)(2)(vi)

Within five (5) days following an accidental discharge, the permittee shall submit a detailed written report describing the cause(s) of the discharge and the measures to be taken to prevent similar future occurrences. The report shall be submitted to:

The Slug Discharge Report shall address (at a minimum) the following:

Information to Report:

1. Material spilled/discharged
2. Quantity spilled/Quantity of material + wastewater discharged
3. Date & Time of spill/discharge
4. Location(s) of spill/discharge
5. Site Name(s) of spill/discharge
6. Site Address, and
7. Description of what happened and/or the cause of the discharge
8. Description of the current situation
9. List of people/agencies who have been already contacted.
10. Describe the measures to be taken by the user to prevent similar future occurrences
11. The following certification statement must be signed by an officer of the company or manager responsible for overall plant operations, and submitted to the City of Phoenix Environmental Services Division:

“Based on my inquiry of the person or persons directly responsible for managing compliance with the slug control measures in the Slug Control Plan (SCP), I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, this facility is implementing the slug control plan submitted to the City of Phoenix. Furthermore, I certify that the slug prevention and control equipment installed at this facility will provide adequate protection from slug loading and will be used and maintained properly.”

NOTE: Slug discharge refers to the material discharged to the sanitary sewer and spill refers to material spilled to natural outlets, the roadway, or the storm sewer.

Such notification shall not relieve the user of any expense, loss, damage, or other liability which may be incurred as a result of damage to the POTW, fish kills, or any other damage to person or property; nor shall such notification relieve the user of any fines, civil penalties, or other liability which may be imposed by this Article or other applicable law.
