The Phoenix Police Department (PPD) is requesting an add-on item to the City Council's April 2, 2014, formal meeting agenda for an item to amend Agreement #125890 with Versaterm, Inc. for the Department's Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and 911 systems in the amount of \$240,000. Authorization is also requested for the City Controller to disburse funds. Funding is available in the Phoenix Police Department's Capital Improvement Program budget.

As a result of a competitive bid, the PPD has an existing agreement with Versaterm for our CAD and 911 systems. This amendment is necessary for Versaterm to create the interfaces between CAD and 911 and the new Records Management System to meet the July 2014 implementation date.

AMEND AGREEMENT WITH VERSATERM, INC., FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

Request to authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to amend Agreement 125890 with Versaterm, Inc. for the Police Department's Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and 911 systems in the amount of \$240,000. Authorization is also requested for the City Controller to disburse funds.

Versaterm, Inc. was chosen through a competitive bidding process in 2008-2009, as the Police Department's provider for CAD and 911 software. The amendment is necessary to authorize Versaterm, Inc. to create interfaces between CAD and the new records management system, which is scheduled to be implemented this Summer. Versaterm, Inc. owns the intellectual property rights of their software and is the only company capable of supplying this service.

Financial Impact

Funding is available in the Phoenix Police Department's Capital Improvement Program budget.

This request is recommended by the Acting Assistant City Manager and the Chief of Police.

This report is to notify the Council of a change in the staff recommendation for one liquor license item on the April 2, 2014 Formal Council Agenda.

Item 16, District 2, McFadden's Restaurant & Saloon (Series 6)

Staff originally recommended disapproval of this item due to concerns with the applicant's history of liquor license violations. Since that time, the Police Department has submitted a recommendation for disapproval of this item for recent acts of violence at this location and the applicant's history of liquor license violations. Therefore, staff continues to recommend disapproval of this item, adding the attached Police Department recommendation for disapproval.

The Police Department recommends disapproval of this liquor license application for the following reasons:

The owners' other two locations, McFadden's located at 9425 West Coyotes Blvd in Glendale, AZ and Calico Jacks located at 6770 North Sunrise Blvd in Surprise, AZ have a 3-year history consisting of several violations and fines levied related to Repeated Acts of Violence, Selling to Intoxicated or Disorderly Person's, Underage Consumption, Failure to ID, Employee Consuming on Duty, Accepting Unauthorized ID, Failure to Maintain Capability, Qualification and Reliability and Having Intoxicated on Premises for thirty minutes.

The original application was for a Series 12 license but it appeared the location was actually being operated as a bar requiring a Series 6 liquor license similar to the owners two other locations, which are operated as bars under Series 6 licenses. The new location is similar to the Series 6 location in Glendale in scope of types of tables appearing to be more than 60% for alcohol consumption, advertisement of promotions and alcohol consumption, business plan operations indicate more of a sports bar atmosphere (24 TV's), staffing of security, layout of location to include an outside bar area.

The two major concerns for the precinct, were the series type the applicant was applying for, and the repeated acts of violence that have occurred at the applicants other two locations.

After speaking with the applicant, the applicant decided to apply for a Series 6. The applicant addressed the precincts concerns about the repeated acts of violence by stating McFadden's at Desert Ridge would cater to a different clientele, would have a different environment and would not attract the crowd that the other two locations attract; being that they are located near the Phoenix Stadium.

Since having this conversation, McFadden's at Desert Ridge has had two recent acts of violence, both occurring on 03/18/2014. This would contradict the applicant's statement that the location of this McFadden's would prevent the acts of violence that the other two locations have.

The applicants have failed to maintain the capability, qualifications and reliability for the licenses they already have. The applicant has already failed to maintain the capability, qualifications, and reliability for this application for their Desert Ridge location. For these reasons the Police Department recommends denial.
