

## AUGUST 28, 2018 SPECIAL ELECTION

### CLOSE OF EARLY VOTING

The last day to request an early ballot for the Primary/Special City of Phoenix Election is Friday, Aug. 17, 2018 and the last day to vote early in person is Friday, Aug. 24, 2018. In this election, in addition to Federal, State, and County offices, registered voters residing in the City of Phoenix will vote on six ballot measures referred by the City Council. Proposition 411 is a proposed Charter Amendment related to Dates for Regular City of Phoenix Candidate Elections. Proposition 412 is a proposed Charter Amendment related to the Power of the City Council to Remove Elective Office Holders. Proposition 413 is related to a Southwest Gas Corporation Franchise Agreement. Proposition 414 is a proposed Charter Amendment related to the Referral of Charter Amendments, while Proposition 415 is a proposed Charter Amendment related to the Citizens' Commission on Salaries for Elected City Officials. Proposition 416 is a proposed Charter Amendment related to the Random Sample Verification for Initiative and Referendum Petitions. The last day to register to vote in this election was Monday, July 30, 2018.

#### Early Voting by Mail

Voted early ballots must be mailed or delivered to the Maricopa County Elections Department so that they are received by 7 p.m. on Election Day (Tuesday, Aug. 28, 2018). If you return your ballot by mail, be sure to allow sufficient time for delivery by Election Day. It is recommended you mail your ballot at least six days before Election Day. Voters also may deliver their voted early ballots to early voting locations or to any polling place in Maricopa County on Election Day, Tuesday, Aug. 28, 2018, before the polls close at 7 p.m.

Voters should take the time they need to consider the choices and mark their ballot. However, voters who complete their ballots early are encouraged to return the ballot as soon as it is voted. Returning voted ballots as early as possible provides more time for signature verification and processing so that final results are available sooner.

#### Early Voting Locations and Accessible Voting Equipment

Early voting sites are available from Aug. 1 through Aug. 24, 2018 for voters to cast an early ballot or exchange a damaged or spoiled early ballot. Any voter may cast an early ballot at any of these locations. Accessible voting devices that allow voters with disabilities to vote independently are also available at these sites.
