RE: ASU Sun Devil Baseball Games

Dear Mr. Vujs,

Thank you for communicating with our team regarding your planned activity of ASU Sun Devil Baseball games beginning on March 5, 2021. Under normal conditions the City of Phoenix would not be involved in a "special event" like this however, during this pandemic the Governor's Executive Order 2020-43 authorizes the City of Phoenix to approve "public event" greater than 50 people if the plan is to implement "adequate safety precautions."

It should be clearly understood that approval does not mean your guests, or your staff, are not at risk from the COVID-19 pandemic. There is no pathway we could outline that would establish with 100% certainty that no one will contract the virus. Additionally, the City of Phoenix accepts no liability, and offers no indemnification, for anyone electing to be at this event. Finally, the plan needs to include a waiver that includes the City of Phoenix.

Our understanding of the event is as follow:

- Significantly reduced capacity
- Safety plan consistent with prior approved sporting events
- Social distanced POD seating
- Increased security to enforce guidelines
- Masks required at event
- Testing protocols for players and staff
- Eating and drinking only allowed while seated in pod
- Mobile ticketing only
- First row of seats around the entire facility will not be ticketed
- Suites will not be in use
- Concessions are limited to prepackaged
- Bottle beverages will be sold, no fountain drinks or draft beers
- Gaiters are not permitted as acceptable face mask
- Hand sanitizing dispensers have been installed in all public restrooms

In addition to the above, we require the following stipulations:

- Use zip ties or some other form of barrier to block seats instead of crime scene type tape
- Assign COVID compliance Monitor to ensure fans are adhering with face covering, social distancing and seating requirements
- Health screening questionnaire for staff and attendees prior to entry to the event

The City of Phoenix is approving the event scheduled to begin March 5, 2021. While we are approving your submitted plan we reserve the right to re-evaluate that approval if there is evidence that you are not complying with the protocols set forth in your plan or if there is a sudden and dramatic increase in the COVID-19 infection rates within our community.”

The COVID-19 Operational Protocols that you are required to implement and enforce will be posted on the City’s website and a copy will be submitted to the Arizona Department of Health Services in accordance with Executive Order 2020-59 issued by the Governor on December 2, 2020.

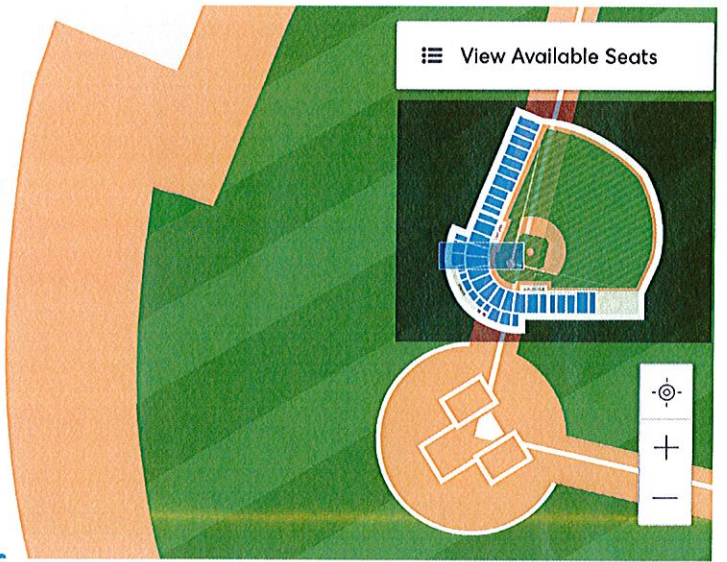
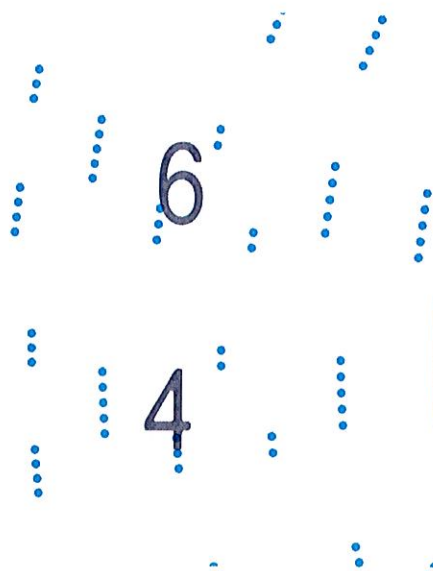
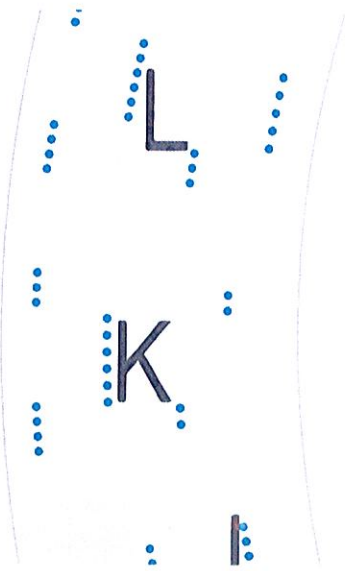
Special Event COVID Pre-Application

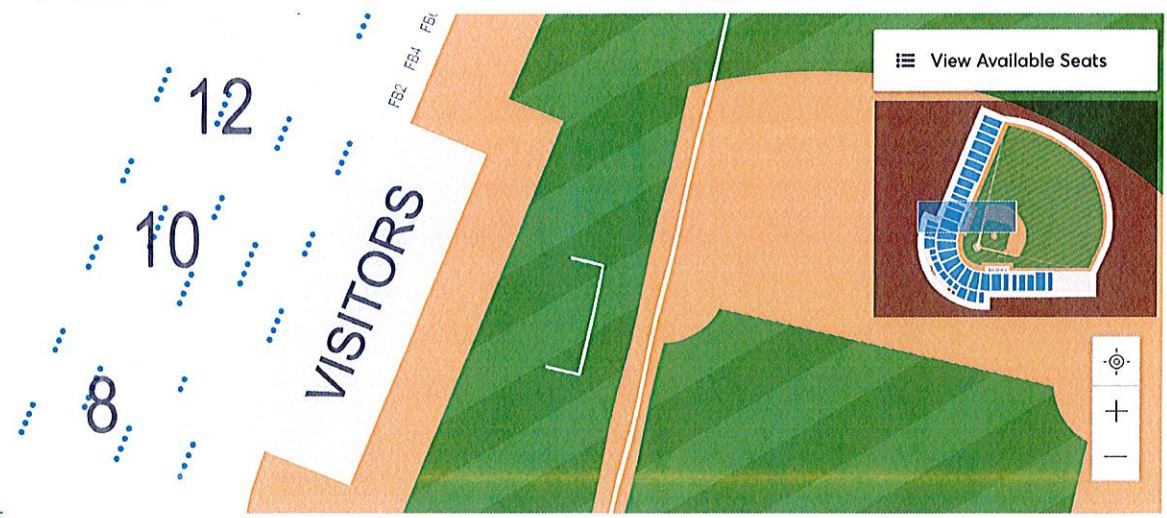

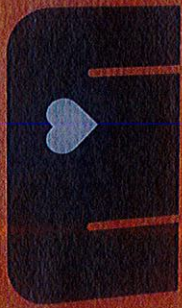

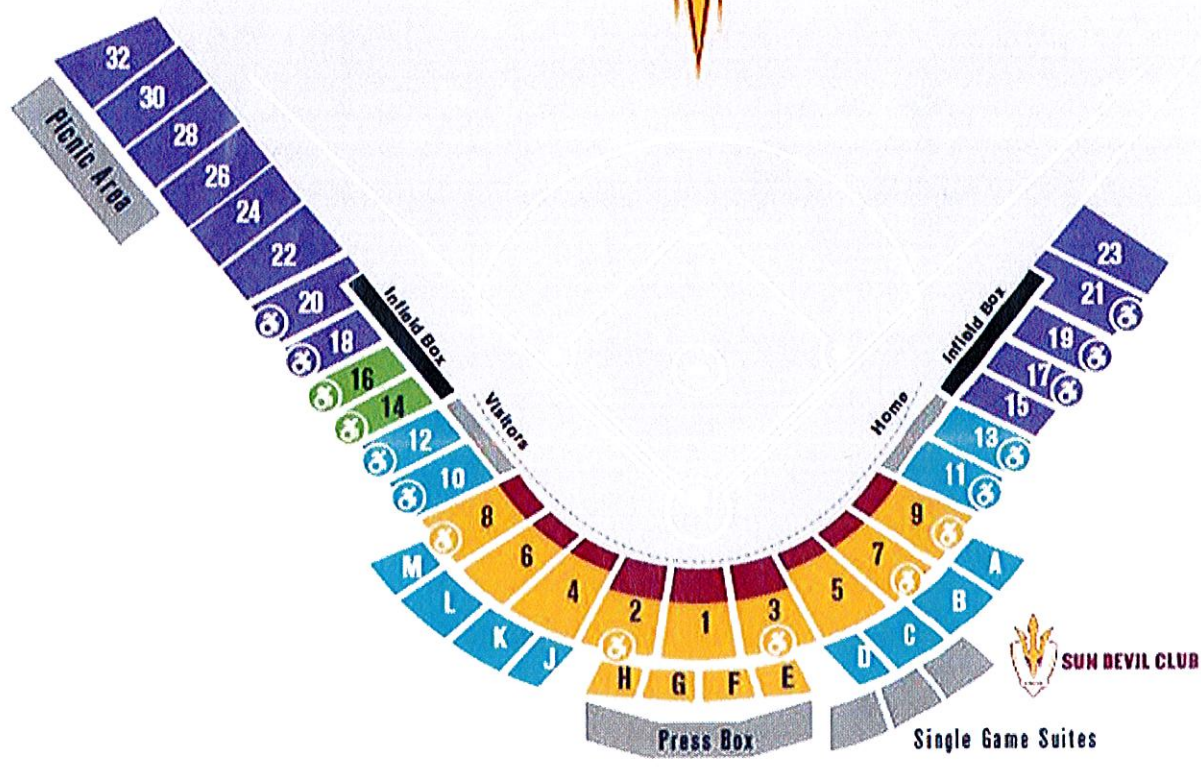

SPRING SPORT FAN ATTENDANCE

/// PLAN OVERVIEW

The safety and health of our student-athletes, fans, students, and staff is our top priority. This plan describes the protocols that will be in place to ensure the well being of everyone in attendance at Sun Devil Athletics Baseball and other outdoor spring sports.

Sun Devils believe in a community of care.

As Sun Devils, we take care of ourselves, each other and our community. We know that sporting events look different, and we want to express our thank you to everyone doing their part to slow the spread of COVID-19 to keep our community healthy and well.

Our goal is to provide guidance on preventative measures that we have implemented to create a safe and welcoming environment where fans can connect with Sun Devil Athletics.

The following areas are addressed:

- Ticketing and Parking
- Concessions
- Staffing
- Security and Prohibited Items
- Cleaning and Hygiene
- Fan Accountability
- Player Safety

/// TICKETING AND PARKING



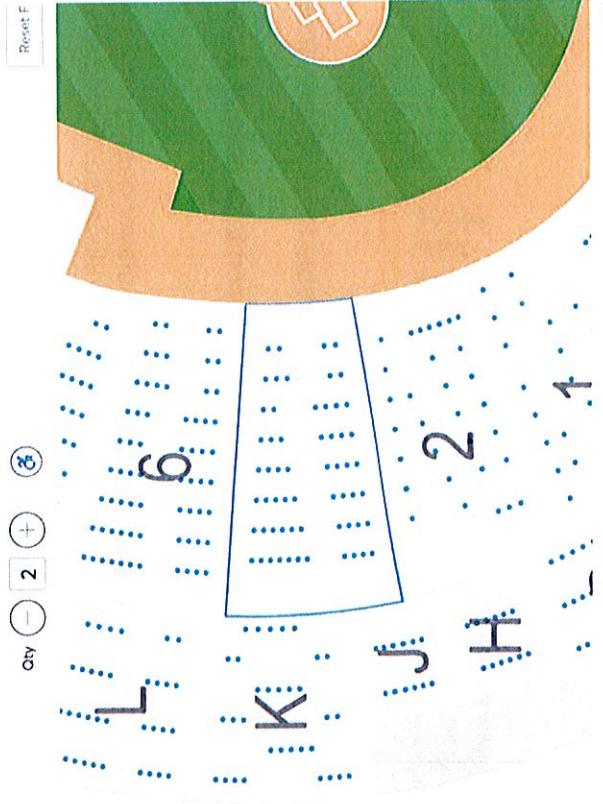
TICKETING

- Tickets will be limited and distributed in seating pods (no greater than six seats) that are located at least six (6) feet apart. There will be no general admission seating available for Spring of 2021.
- To accommodate physical distancing, capacity at Phoenix Municipal Stadium will be reduced to 1,770; 26% of the normal capacity of 6,968.
- The first row of seats around the entire facility will not be ticketed and will be marked off with caution tape.
- All tickets will be mobile delivery only.
- Priority will be given to season ticket holders (900 seats) and students. The student section will be made up of seating pods of two seats; one for the student and one for a member of their immediate household.

TICKETING (cont.)

- If a limited number of single game tickets are available for purchase, they will be promoted as advance on-line sale only.
- Unused seats will either be tied off with yellow caution tape or have a cardboard fan cutout inserted to prevent fans from relocating outside of their assigned pod.
- The Ticket Office is open to distribute tickets to the player guests and answer customer service questions. The number of ticket windows is reduced to three windows to allow staff to physically distance. Plexiglass is installed at all ticket windows.
- Suites and Devil Deck will not be in use for Spring 2021.

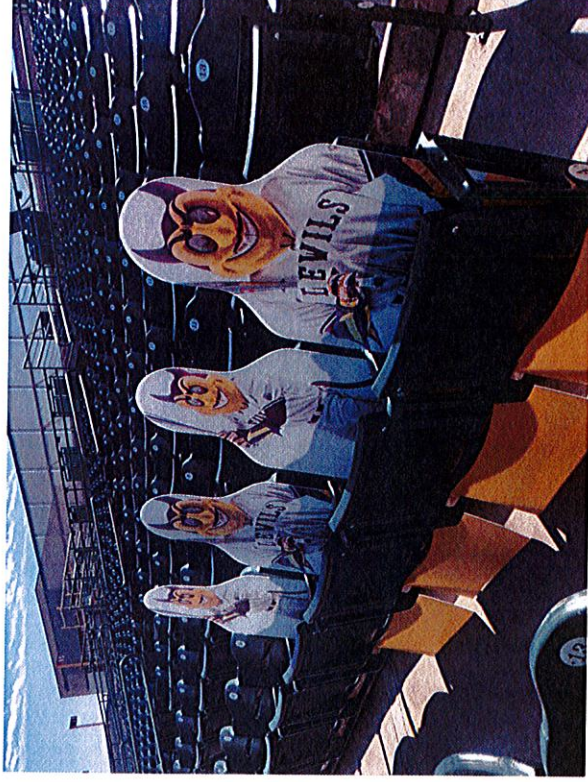
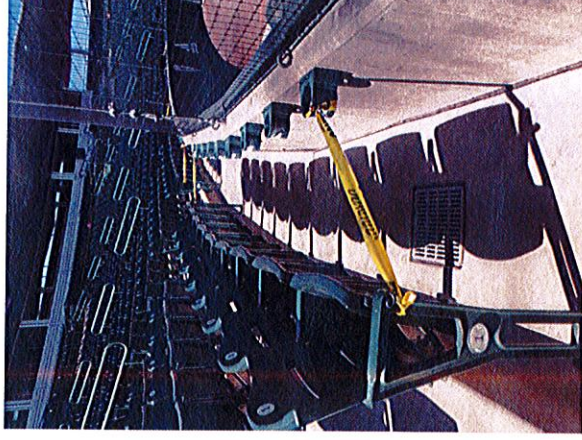
Ticket Seating Diagram



- All pods are verified to be more than six (6) ft. apart.
- Seated rows are separated by a non-seated row.
- The first row of the venue is not seated.

- Unused seats and rows are tied off with yellow caution tape or have a cardboard fan cutout inserted

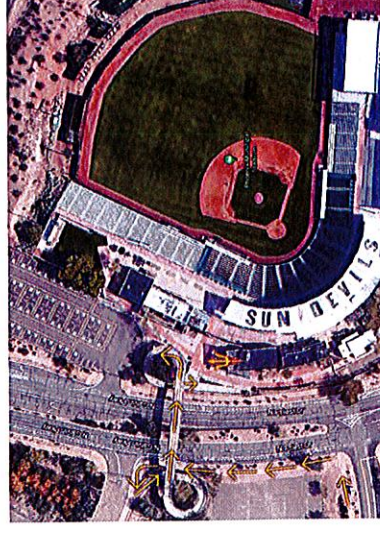


PARKING

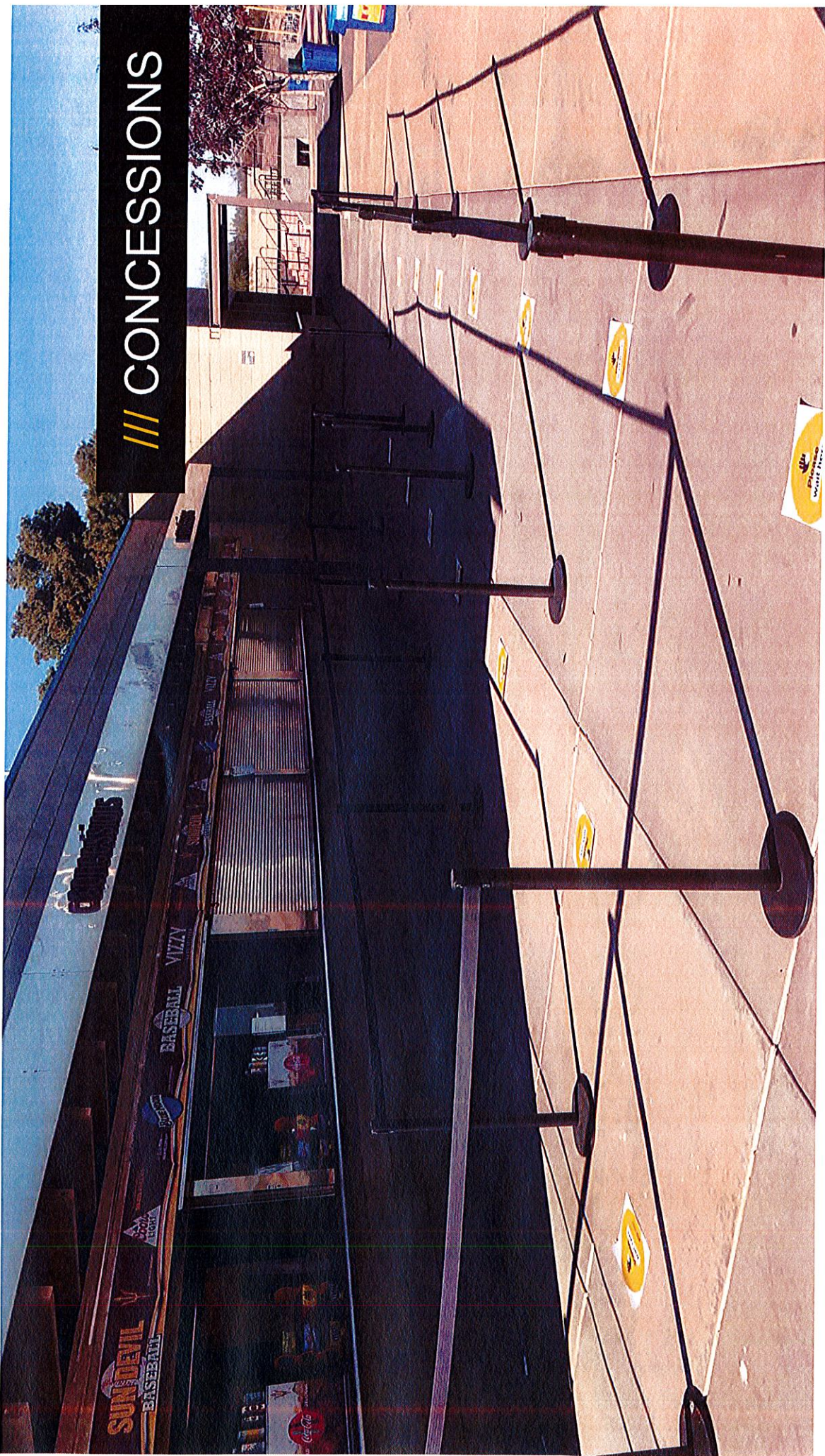
- Due to the Covid-19 Vaccine being administered in the Phoenix Municipal parking lot, general parking is relocated to the Salt River Project parking lot.
- All season ticket holders will have a mobile parking pass. Single game parking will be free of charge on a first come, first served basis.
- The ADA lot will remain in place in front of the stadium.
- All parking lots will be staffed with a parking attendant with proper PPE and physical distancing. The attendant will direct fans to the access ramp for the stadium.
- A shuttle with reduced capacity is provided for patrons of limited mobility.

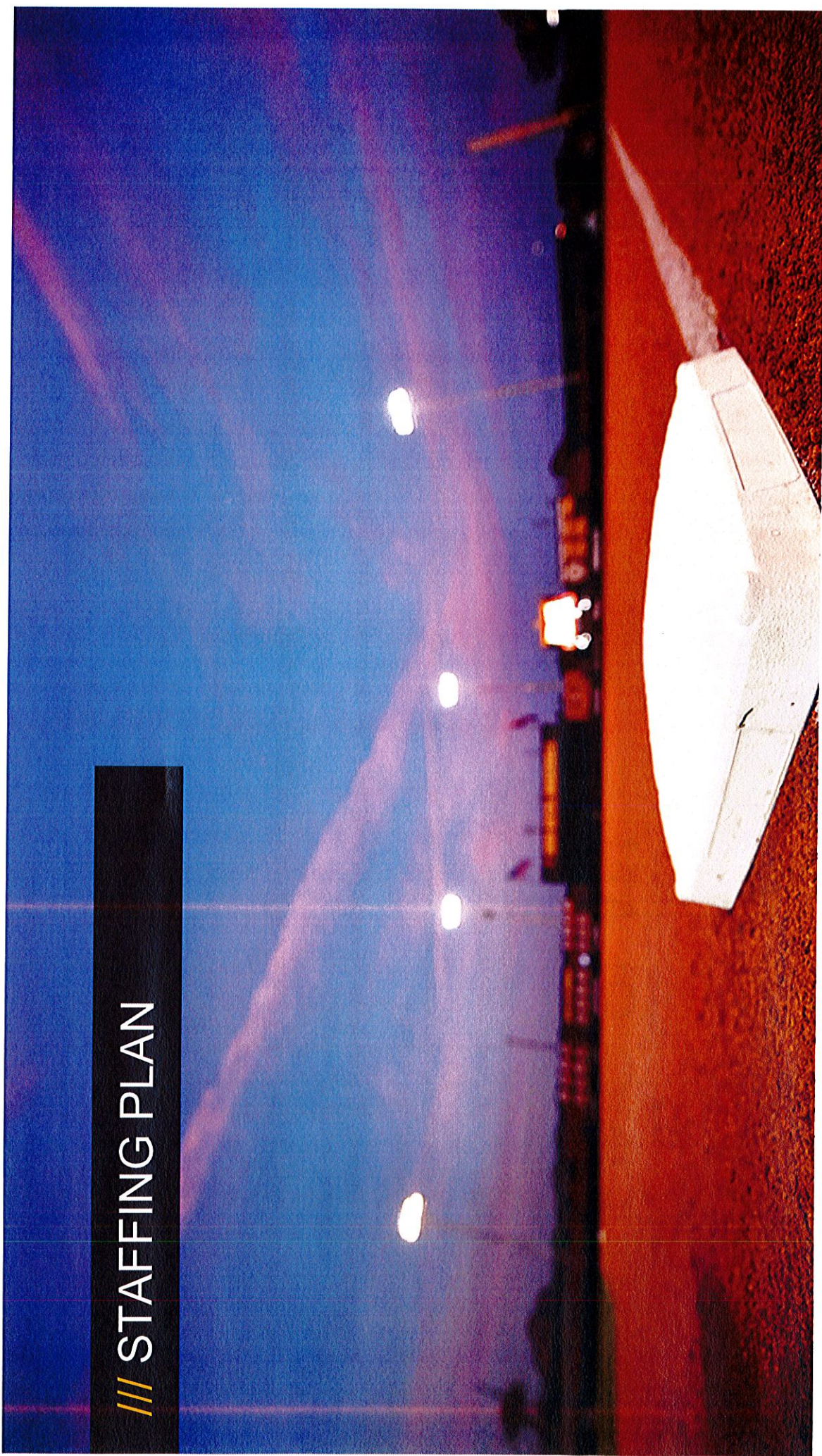
/// CONCESSIONS

CONCESSIONS

- The concession stands will be staffed at less than 50% normal, using every other Point of Sale.
- The menu is limited to prepacked, Fan Favorite items. All condiments will be included in the packaging.
- Only bottled beverages will be sold; no fountain drinks or draft beers.
- There is a plexiglass barrier between the guests and the staff. All staff will wear appropriate masks and gloves. The staff will complete the same entrance protocols as full-time staff.
- The lines will be one-way directional paths, using stanchions, from entrance to exit with six ft. markings. There will be signage throughout the line to assist the guests.
- All concession stands are credit card enabled for fans to pay quickly and without cash if they prefer.
- There is an active liquor license for Phoenix Municipal Stadium.



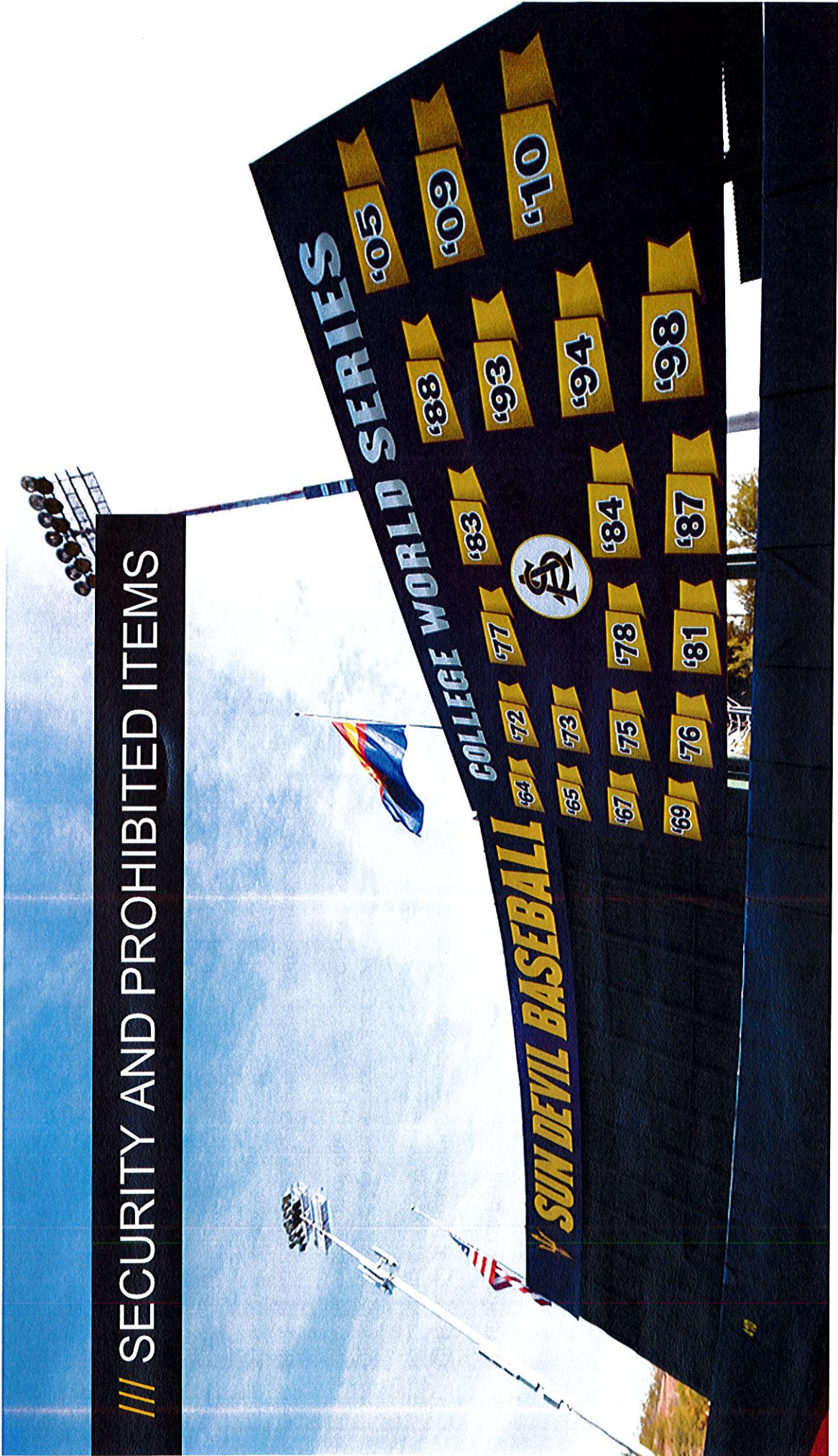
/// STAFFING PLAN



STAFFING PLAN

- All employees will be required to wear adequate face coverings while working at Sun Devil Athletic events. Adequate face coverings are either surgical masks or cloth masks with multiple layers of fabric.
- Single-layer neck fleece covers, also known as gaiters, and face coverings with valves do not satisfy the requirement for use of a face covering at Sun Devil Athletics facilities.
- There is a single entrance for employees. All employees will have their temperature checked and be subject to a pre-screening questionnaire prior to entering the facility.
- Staff will be required to follow physical distancing guidelines at all times, including in the ticket office, press box, and concession stands.

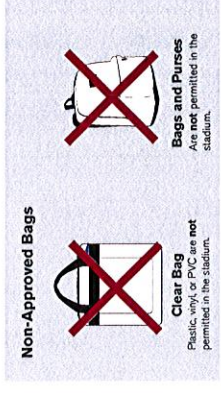
PROHIBITED ITEMS

- To minimize touch points between security personnel and fans, **NO** bags will be permitted in Sun Devil Athletic Facilities.
- Only medical bags, manufactured diaper bags, and purses not exceeding 5" x 8" will be permitted.
- Outside food and beverages will not be permitted, with the exception of one (1) sealed plastic water bottle.
- No bag policy signage is located at the street crossing and all stadium entrances.
- Parking lot attendants will notify fans of the policy when exiting their vehicles.

ASU No Bag Policy

Bags or purses of any size are NOT permitted. Small clutches no larger than 5" x 8" x 1" are permitted (see below). All items and persons entering Sun Devil venues are subject to inspection.

Guests entering with medical or child care needs must enter through designated bag entrances (bag check locations at each major gate entrance) to have their items inspected. One 12" x 12" x 6" bag per person will be permitted.

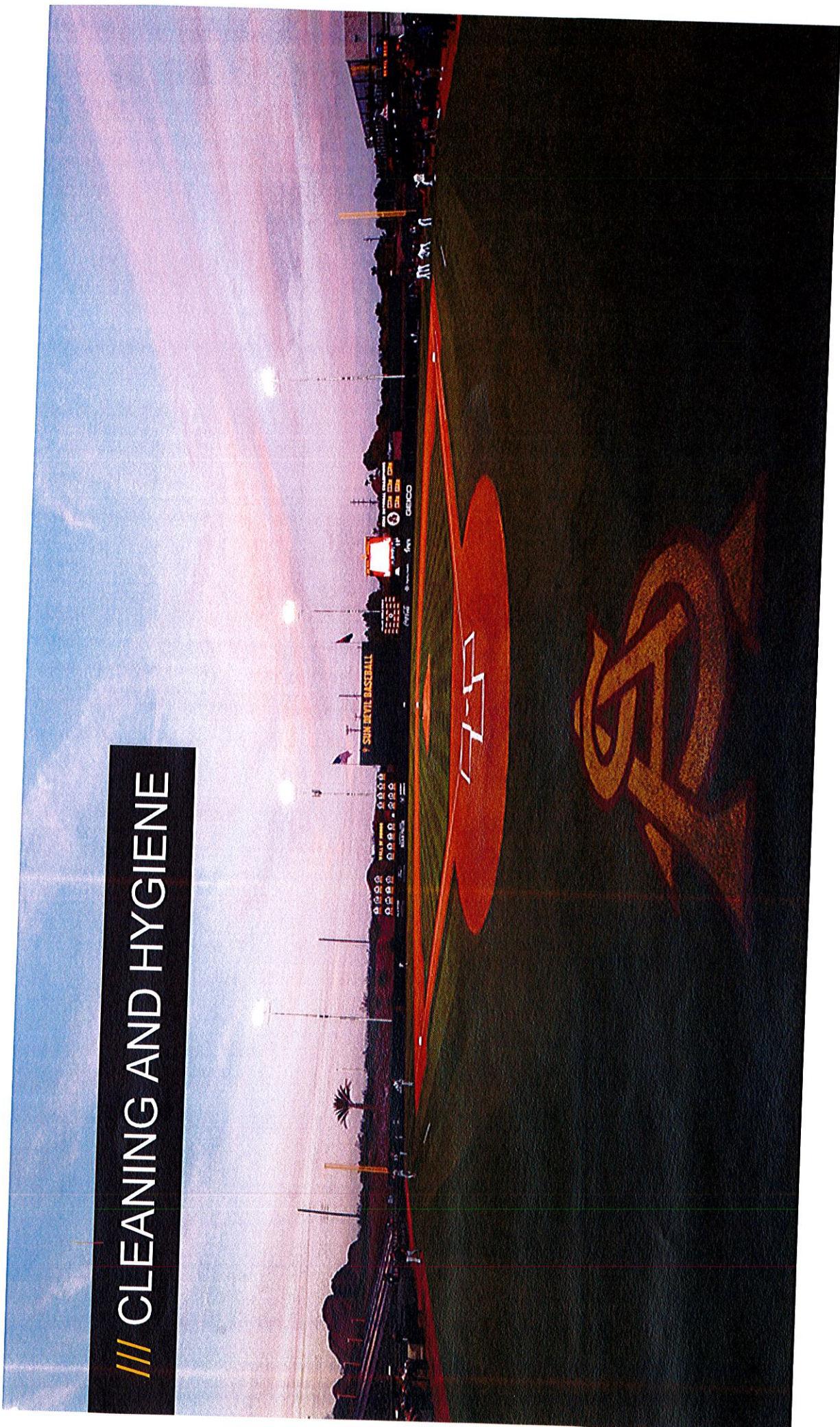

- Sun Devil Athletics does NOT provide a check-in location for prohibited bags/items.
- Medical bags and child care bags are permitted and subject to a thorough inspection.

Clutches that fit inside this 5" x 8" gold box are allowed.

/// CLEANING AND HYGIENE



CLEANING PROCEDURES

Landcorp is under contract for all cleaning services at Phoenix Municipal Stadium.

- Phoenix Municipal Stadium is cleaned daily and before and after games.
- Purtabs chemical is used to disinfect and sanitize (information on page)

HYGIENE PROTOCOLS

HAND WASHING

- To assist with the practice of hand washing, signage will be placed throughout the stadium, in addition to periodic PA announcement.
- Additionally, Sun Devil Athletics have installed touchless soap and paper towel dispensers in all public restrooms.

HAND SANITIZERS

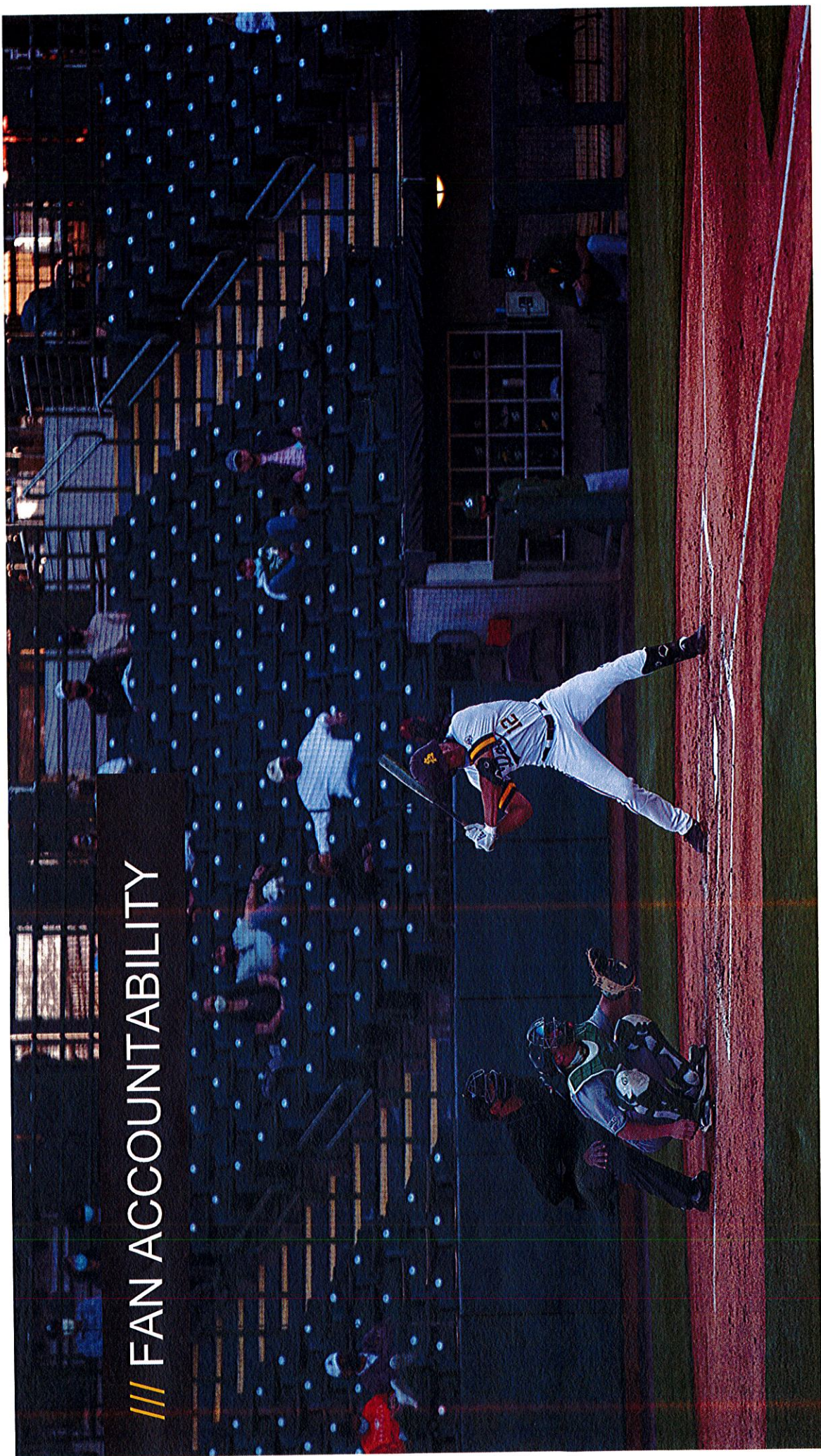
- Hand Sanitizing Dispensers have been installed in all public restrooms.
- Additional “touchless” hand sanitizing stations will be placed in the following locations:
 - Front Gates, Door to all restrooms (total of 16), Stadium Operations/Guest Service Location, Concessions

ADDITIONAL PPE

- Masks and gloves will be available at the entry gates and stadium operations for those fans that may have forgot their mask or need a new one.



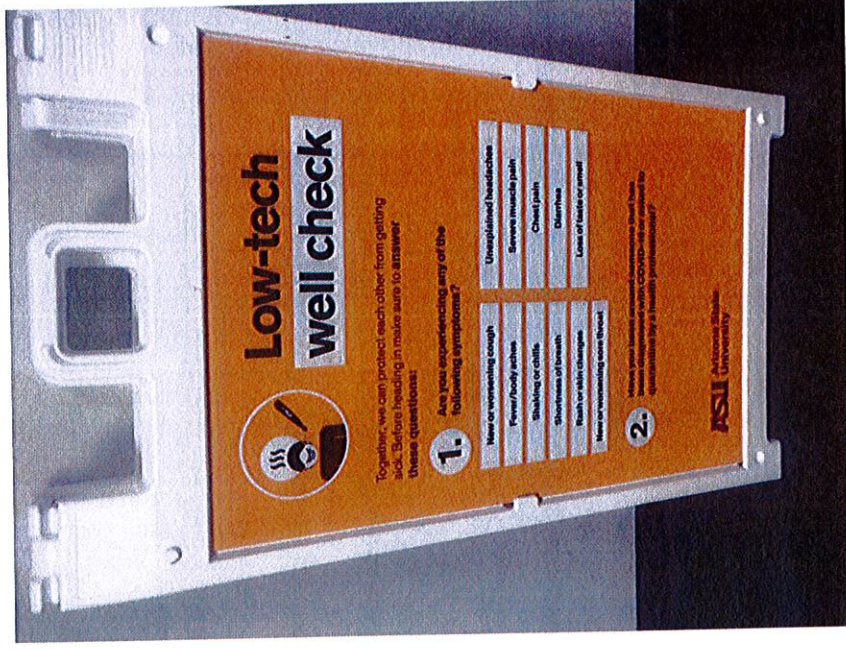
/// FAN ACCOUNTABILITY



FAN ACCOUNTABILITY

- All fans, ages two (2) years and older, must wear a facial covering over their nose and mouth at all times (except when actively eating or drinking in their pod). Security personnel will actively enforce this policy.
- Fans that do not comply are subject to removal from the facility
- Fans must physically distance while on property. Signage will be placed at the main gates and around the concourses.
- Public Address announcements will remind fans throughout the game to respect each other, stay in their designated seats, and wear their face coverings.
- Fan policies will be communicated ahead of time in email, will be listed in their online account manager, and available on TheSunDevils.com website

DUGOUTS

- The first row of seating along the playing surface and behind each dugout will be restricted and tied off with yellow caution tape.
- Sitting/Standing locations will be identified in both the home and visiting team dugouts to identify locations for the coaches and student athletes to properly physically distance from one another at six feet.

BULLPENS

- Folding chairs have been placed in both the home and visiting team bullpens at six feet apart to allow coaches and student athletes to physically distance.

MASKS

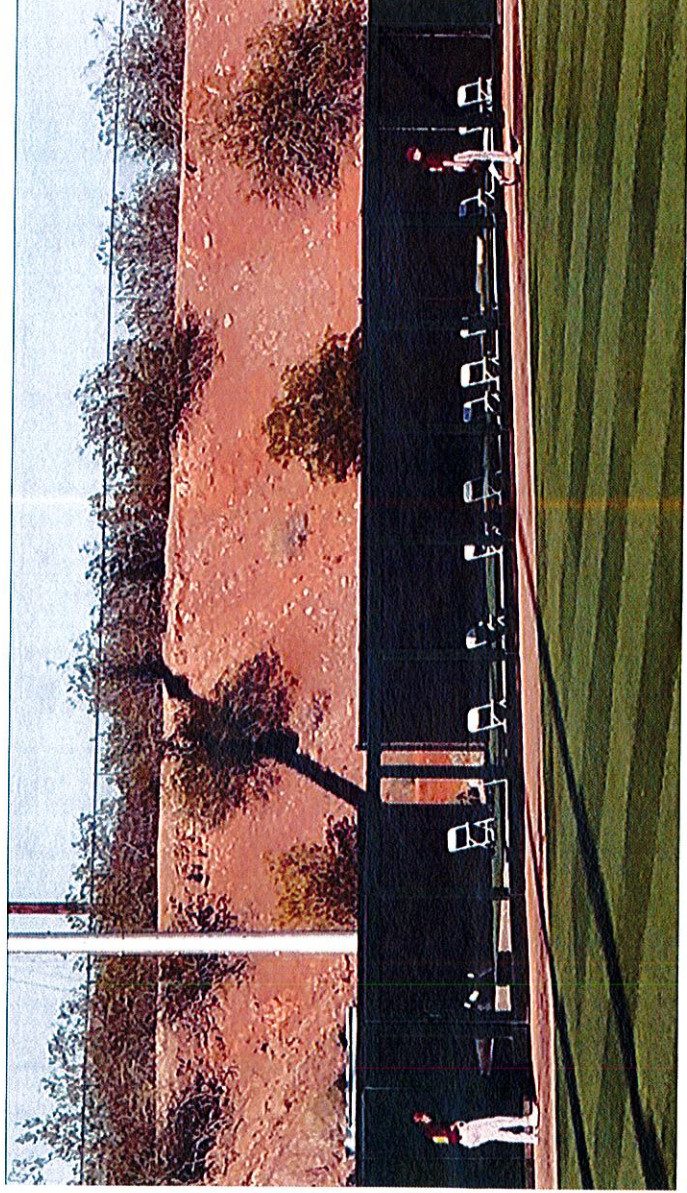
- All student athletes and coaches will be required to wear adequate face coverings in the bullpens and dugouts at Phoenix Municipal Stadium.
- Adequate face coverings are either surgical masks or cloth masks with multiple layers of fabric. Single-layer neck fleece covers, also known as gaiters, and face coverings with valves do not satisfy the requirement for use of a face covering at Sun Devil Athletics facilities.

TESTING REQUIREMENTS

- All umpires will be required to follow Pac-12 Conference testing guidelines which consist of a negative PCR test within 48 hours of game day and a negative Antigen test the day of each competition.
- All Student Athletes, per Pac-12 Conference rules, are required to one time a week PCR surveillance testing.
