Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to outline the seniority formula for all sworn members of the Phoenix Fire Department. Included in the policy are tie-breakers for each respective rank/classification.

SENIORITY FORMULAS

Recruit Class Seniority

- 1. Fire Recruit Classification date
- 2. City of Phoenix employment date (DOH)
- 3. Firefighter Classification date
- 4. Overall percentage of Firefighter Recruit written test scores combined with an overall percentage of successful phase 3 skills evaluations
- 5. Recruit interview (employment) score final
 - *If a tie exists after steps 1-5, utilizing City of Phoenix Tie Breaker Criteria will begin
- 6. Recruit entrance exam score (written) (final eligible list score)
- 7. Total unpaid leave (excluding FMLA, military leave, and furlough)
- 8. City of Phoenix resident
- 9. "not-met" PMG in the previous 12 months OR discipline in personnel file (i.e. written reprimand/suspension)
- 10. Job application date for current job class

Firefighters (Vacation and Station assignment)

- 1. Classification date
- 2. City of Phoenix Employment date (DOH)
- 3. Recruit Class Seniority

Engineer (Vacation)

- 1. Promoted Classification date
- 2. City of Phoenix Employment date (DOH)
- 3. Placement on Promotional list

Engineer (Station Assignments)

1. Placement on Promotional list

Captain (Vacation)

- 1. Promoted Classification date
- City of Phoenix employment date (DOH)
 Placement on promotional list

Captain (Station Assignments)

1. Placement on Promotional list
