- 1. A Cadet, only in good standing, can ride in an official capacity with any single Engine/Ladder/Heavy Rescue a maximum of two (2) times a month.
- 2. The Cadet may ride only with crews of at least three (3) sworn members.
- 3. The Cadet is to wear an approved uniform.
- 4. If seating permits, two Cadets may ride the same apparatus.
- 5. Crew activity, training, call volume, outside agency representative requiring ride times, or any unforeseen events may preclude a Cadet from riding that particular shift. This could occur last minute. All attempts will be made to advise Cadet of this prior to the shift start time.
- 6. Cadet Evaluation Report (form #90-62D) will be provided to the Company Officer at beginning of shift.
- 7. Please be aware the station ride time will <u>not</u> be counted towards the 32-hour minimum volunteer hours required each quarter.
- 8. It is important that each Cadet be aware that riding along at a station is a privilege and should be regarded as such; she/he is there to observe and learn.
- 9. The Cadet **will not be permitted** to operate in a "hot-zone" where an SCBA would be required.
- 10. Cadets are not permitted to use official helmet stickers that indicate the truck they are riding on, as these need to be saved for sworn members entering a "hot zone". Cadets will only have the markings "CADET" and their last name present on their helmets.
- 11. The Management Team expects that the Cadet will be fully informed of the riding procedures/limitations and be able to share the rules with the Company Officer.

COMPANY OFFICERS HAVE THE FINAL SAY ON WHETHER A CADET WILL RIDE ON HER/HIS APPARATUS THAT SHIFT.
