2022-2023 Annual Action Plan Substantial Amendment Public Hearing
and Public Comment Period**

The City of Phoenix has prepared a Substantial Amendment to the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan’s 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan for public comment which includes a public hearing.

The 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan defines how the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) HOME Investment Partnership (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) funds will be used to address the priorities and goals outlined in the five-year Consolidated Plan and is carried out through Annual Action Plans. The 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan provides a concise summary of activities the City will prioritize in fiscal year 2022-2023 to address the priority needs identified by the community in support of the goals outlined in the Consolidated Plan.

This 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan substantial amendment is outlined below.
