VEHICLE SALES

Guidelines

How many vehicles can I sell per year?

The Zoning Ordinance limits the number of vehicles that can be displayed for sale at a residential property to two vehicles displayed for sale within a twelve month period.

Are there any other conditions for displaying vehicles for sale at a residence?

Yes, only one vehicle can be displayed for sale at any given time. The registration of the vehicle must be to the same location where the vehicle is being displayed for sale. Vehicles can not be displayed for sale at vacant properties or vacant lots.

Can a private vehicle be sold at a commercial property?

No, Privately owned vehicles may not be displayed for sale on commercial property unless they are being sold by a licensed commercial auto dealership that has obtained the proper permits.

What is considered a vehicle?

Trailers, watercraft, automobiles, trucks, and transportation built to carry passengers or cargo. Two jet skis, a boat or similar type of recreational vehicles that are transported on one trailer are considered one vehicle for the purpose of display for sale.

What is the maximum penalty for selling vehicles illegally?

The City of Phoenix actively works with residents to educate them on the requirements of the code. Individuals who choose not to comply with the code may face civil and/or criminal charges with penalties up to \$2,500 per charge.
