# **sun Block**









Up to five artists will be selected to design vibrant fabric canopies for personal shade umbrellas. Winning artists will be paid \$3,000 to develop new designs. The umbrellas will be produced and distributed through a campaign to promote awareness about heat and sun safety. Contest is open to Arizona artists new to public art. This Phoenix Office of Arts and Culture Public Art Program Project is part of the SunBLOCK project, supported by an Our Town grant from the National Endowment for the Arts.

Contest entry is simple and free. Apply online at: www.callforentry.org Submission Requirements:

- **1.** Five digital images showing your best, previously completed two-dimensional artwork
- Digital images must be JEPG only.
- JPEGs must be under 5 MB each and 1,200 pixels or greater on the longest side.
- Do not include more than one image in each JPEG.
- Do not submit design proposals for umbrella artwork.
- Do not put your name on the JPEGs.

2. A short, one-paragraph biography


3. An image list that includes the artwork title, dimensions and completion date. If any work represents a collaboration with other artists, list them and describe your and their roles in creating the work.

• Selected artists will design the perforated steel panels.




• Artist will select colors for the powder coated

#### **Estimated Budget**

The amount available for designing the transit shelter shade screens will depend partly on the scope of design services for the different shelter sites, but it is not expected to exceed \$10,000. This amount would be expected to cover the artist design fee and all costs associated with the design process (insurance, fax, mileage, research, community engagement, materials, etc.)
