PROCESS:

For projects requiring a Preliminary Site Plan review, the applicant shall submit this form and may provide a narrative of Complete Streets design elements included in the project that are in addition to required codes and ordinances and support the City adopted Complete Streets Design Guidelines. The applicant shall include a copy of this completed form and, if applicable, the narrative, with the Preliminary submittal to the Planning and Development Department.

The following is a list of Complete Streets Design Guidelines subsets that projects can expound on in a narrative for possible consideration and inclusion in the project:

- > **Design for Context:** Design considers and supports the vision of the existing community.
- > **Design for Safety:** Design considers and supports safe use of the right of way.
- **Design for Connectivity:** Design considers and supports interconnectivity within the project context.
- > Design for Comfort and Convenience: Design considers user comfort and convenience.
- > Design for Sustainability: Design considers and supports sustainable elements.
