- Three (3) sets of Carbon Dioxide Beverage System plans. Plans shall be submitted on 24" x 36" sheets, including:
- Site plan
  - Elevations
  - Floor plan showing piping diagram, all alarm and detection device locations.

**Note:** If submitting through the Electronic Plan Review system, multiple copies of submittal documents are not required.

- Manufacturer cut sheets (piping, storage vessel, detection alarms and cabinet).

**Note:** Modifications to all existing Carbon Dioxide Systems are to be submitted to the Fire Department.

**Per the requirements of state law, this permit application is:**

- Accepted as administratively complete.
- Deficient, items marked above are required for plan acceptance.
