

JOURNEYMAN LICENSE RENEWALS

A Journeyman license is valid for three (3) years. Two months prior to the expiration date, the City of Phoenix will mail out an open book renewal exam. The exam(s) will be mailed to the address on file. **Ensure address is updated.** It is your responsibility to ensure you renew prior to expiration. There are no exceptions or grace periods.

Fees are as follows:

- Plumber & Gas Fitter \$ 40.00
- Mechanical \$ 40.00
- Gas Fitter \$ 40.00
- Mechanical & Gas Fitter \$ 40.00
- Plumbing, Mechanical & Gas Fitter \$ 80.00

The minimum passing grade is 70%.

Failure to pass any renewal examination will require the applicant to retake and pass the initial Journeyman exam.

Any license that is issued based upon fraudulent information will be voided immediately and appropriate legal action will be taken.

To obtain an apprentice license, the applicant must:

- Complete a City of Phoenix Application.
- Present a current picture I.D.

REQUIREMENTS – JOURNEYMAN

To obtain a journeyman license, the applicant must:

- Complete a City of Phoenix Application.
- Provide proof of at least four (4) years of experience.
- Present a current picture I.D.
- Pass the journeyman test with a minimum score of 75%.

The tests are based on the following codes:

Plumber/Gas Fitter

JOURNEYMAN LICENSE

A journeyman license is valid for three (3) years. Report to the City of Phoenix to obtain your new license.

Fees are as follows:

- Plumber & Gas Fitter \$ 50.00
- Mechanical \$ 50.00
- Gas Fitter \$ 50.00
- Mechanical & Gas Fitter \$ 50.00
- Plumbing, Mechanical & Gas Fitter \$ 100.00

JOURNEYMAN LICENSE

The Phoenix Building Construction Code (PBCC), Administrative Provision, Section 119.1 states all work performed on plumbing and mechanical systems where a permit is required is to be performed by a licensed Journeyman or by an Apprentice. A Journeyman license is valid for 3 years.

ARIZONA REGISTRAR OF CONTRACTORS

The Phoenix Building Construction Code (PBCC), Administrative Provision, Section 119.1 states a person licensed by the State of Arizona as a licensed contractor (qualifying person) need not obtain a Journeyman license or be an apprentice to observe or perform work covered by the PBCC. A licensed contractor may choose to obtain a Journeyman license and will be required to provide verification of the qualifying party and pay the \$50.00 fee. At the time of renewal, the contractor may choose to take the renewal exam for \$40.00 or simply obtain a new license for \$50.00.

APPRENTICE LICENSE

The Phoenix Building Construction Code, Administrative Provision, Section 119.4 states an apprentice must work under the supervision of a licensed Journeyman or Arizona State licensed contractor at all times work is being performed.
