



Maintenance Requirements for Parklet Revocable Permit

- Throughout the term of this permit, the permittee shall assume, at their own expense, the responsibilities for the maintenance and repair of the parklet. The permittee shall ensure the parklet remains in a good, clean and safe condition in accordance with the terms of this permit.
- The parklet shall, at all times, be free of trip hazards.
- The permittee shall perform maintenance and replacement of the parklet platform, railings, furnishings and planters in a timely manner and all costs thereof shall be borne by the permittee.
- The permittee shall respond promptly to any request by the City for repairs, replacements, modifications or adjustments to the parklet and immediately notify the City of the status of any such request.
- The permittee shall ensure that the gutter areas below and adjacent to the Platform are free of debris of any kind and that water flow is not affected by the Platform.
- The parklet, including five (5) feet on either end, will be swept and otherwise cleared of all debris at least once every other week. All trash will be removed from the parklet and hauled with the regular trash hauling provided for by the subject property.
- The permittee shall clean the parklet surface, incorporated benches/furniture and road surface below the parklet on a regular basis. Such cleaning shall include, but not be limited to, graffiti and chewing gum removal.
