

Pool Spa Permit Guidelines Residential Submittals

Purpose

This is a guideline for the submittal of plans for new swimming pools/spas as well as attached water features or structures that add a surcharge or load to a pool/spa design and the associated pool/spa equipment. Please also see available example drawings for use by homeowners, contractors, or developers.

Definitions:

Custom Pool/Spa

A custom pool is an engineered pool design for use at one site specific location.

Note: Custom pools are required to be logged in for review under an RPRM plan review type.

Grotto

A small picturesque cave feature, indoor structure resembling a cave composed of real rock, stone/boulders or manmade material.

Note: Plans with this feature require a structural review as a custom pool/spa design if it is not a feature on an approved pool standard plan on file with the Planning and Development Department.

Rock Water Fall

A structure composed of real rock, stone/boulders or manmade materials in which the water flows through or over, to create a waterfall like feature.

Note: Plans with this feature requires a structural review as a custom pool/spa design if it is not a feature on an approved pool standard plan on file with the Planning and Development Department.

Standard Pool/Spa

A standard pool/spa is an approved engineered standard plan that is on file with the City of Phoenix Planning and Development Department.

Note: A standard design does not include the use of a standard pool/spa plan with structural modifications of any kind. If changes are made, then see definition for custom pool.

Water feature

A water feature with no structural component or materials, consisting of water flowing from a fountain type fixture.

Standard Pool Submittal Requirements

The customer is required to have the following for a complete submittal:

- 1. A completed pool/spa application
- 2. Two (2) copies of plot plans which must be drawn to scale and dimensions.
- **3.** Plot plan must include:
 - a) North arrow
 - b) All property lines
 - c) Swimming pool/spa specifications
 - d) Footprint of all structures identified on property (outline) showing placement on the property and front, side and rear yard setbacks
 - e) Footprint of swimming pool/spa and location of filter and pump and any other accessory equipment
 - f) Location and dimensions of all easements
 - g) Location of fence, wall or other barrier enclosing the swimming pool/spa
 - h) Scale used for drawing

When using a standard plan, the submittal must also include;

- **4.** Two (2) sealed letters on company letterhead giving the customer/pool builder permission to use the approved pool/spa standard plan that is on file with the City of Phoenix
- 5. One (1) copy of the Engineering details to be presented at the job site
- 6. A \$75.00 plot plan review fee (charged at the time of log in)

Note: See definitions of standard pool/spa vs. custom pool/spa for clarification on review and permit process.

Where to submit for approved standard pool/spa designs:

Applications are available online and may be submitted in one of the following;

 All attachments must be in a readily accessible format, preferably PDF. Maximum sheet size is 8.5 inches x 11 inches.
- In person at the Payments and Submittals Counter located on the 2nd Floor at 200 West Washington Street. Request a ticket at the Information Counter between the hours of 8am and 4pm Monday- Friday.

Custom Pool Submittal Requirements

The customer is required to have the following for a complete submittal:

- 1. A completed pool/spa application
- 2. Two (2) copies of plot plans which must be drawn to scale and dimensions.
- 3. Plot plan must include:
 - a) North arrow
 - b) All property lines
 - c) Swimming pool/spa specifications

- d) Footprint of all structures identified on property (outline) showing placement on the property and front, side and rear yard setbacks
- e) Footprint of swimming pool/spa and location of filter and pump and any other accessory equipment
- f) Location and dimensions of all easements
- g) Location of fence, wall or other barrier enclosing the swimming pool/spa
- h) Scale used for drawing
- 4. Two (2) original sets of the site specific engineering for the structural features of the pool
- 5. Two (2) sets of calculations (if applicable –sealed is acceptable but not required)
- 6. A review fee is charged at the time of log in and amount is valuation based.

Note: Structures that add a surcharge

A structure such as a slide, swim up bar, or shade cover will add a surcharge or gravity load to an engineered pool/spa wall. This includes structures attached to a pool/spa wall, or a structure with footings that at a minimum do not meet a ratio of 1' distance from the edge of a footing to the edge of a pool/spa wall, for every 1' of pool/spa depth.
