

## **Open Land Use Summary of Requirements**

<u>Overview</u>: Open Land Uses include such uses as mulching operations, asphalt shingles processing, tire storage, pallet storage and landfill activities. Open Land Uses are subject to Zoning Ordinance, Building Code, Fire Code, and certain other City, County, State and Federal ordinances. A fact finding submittal is advised with a multi-disciplinary review of the project site plan prior to log in of improvement plans to identify recommendations and requirements.
