Fatal Traffic Collision Investigation

On March 9, 2021 at about 7:02 p.m., Phoenix Police officers responded to a vehicle collision involving a pedestrian at Indian School Road and 16th Street. Detectives learned a 51-year-old male attempted to cross 16th Street mid-block when he was struck by a southbound 2003 Ford Ranger operated by a 21-year-old male.

The Phoenix Fire personnel responded and transported the pedestrian to a hospital where he was later pronounced deceased. The driver of the vehicle remained on scene. He was evaluated for symptoms of impairment and none were detected. There were no reported injuries to the driver or passenger of the truck.

The investigation is ongoing.
