Incident: 2022-890325

Location: 43rd Avenue and Northern Avenue

Victim: Adele Adwar Murad, 33-year-old female, deceased

Mid-Day Fatal Collision

(June 13, 2022): A vehicle overturns after it is T-boned inside an intersection. The driver is transported to the hospital but dies from her injuries.

Phoenix Police officers responded to a call of a vehicle collision on 43rd Avenue and Northern Avenue just after 11:15 a.m. When officers arrived, they find an SUV that flipped on its roof and a 4-door passenger car with front-end damage and the airbags deployed. The driver of the SUV, 33-year-old Adele Adwar Murad, was found inside the vehicle.

Adwar Murad was extricated out of the SUV and was rushed to the hospital where she later died from her injuries.

The driver of the vehicle which collided with Adwar Murad remained on scene and suffered non-life-threatening injuries. The driver was taken to the hospital where he received treatment for his injuries.

The investigation remains active. No arrests have been made at this time. Preliminary information suggests the passenger vehicle ran the red light and collided with the SUV as it was attempting to make a left turn. Impairment does not appear to be a factor.
