Aggravated Assault Investigation

Phoenix police are investigating a homicide that has left a 42-year-old male seriously injured.

On April 2nd around 10 p.m. Phoenix police were called to the area of 13000 North 20th Street about a shooting. Officers arrived and found an adult male with a gunshot wound. He was transported to a local hospital with life threatening injuries. At this time Detectives are actively investigating this incident to determine what led up to this shooting.
