Death Investigation

Phoenix, Arizona (March 27th, 2022): Phoenix homicide detectives are investigating the death of a newborn male found inside the bathroom of a fast food restaurant.

On Sunday, around 2:00 p.m., Phoenix Police responded to an injured person call at a fast food restaurant near 33rd Avenue and Indian School Road. When officers responded to the scene, they located a newborn infant inside the bathroom. Officers attempted live-saving measures until the Phoenix Fire Department arrived and pronounced the infant deceased on scene.

Homicide detectives responded to the area where they spoke to witnesses, processed the crime scene, and collected evidence.

There were witnesses at the scene who left prior to police officers arriving. Video surveillance was obtained, and an unknown adult female was seen leaving the bathroom before the infant was located.

There are no suspects in custody. The autopsy results of the infant are pending. The investigation is ongoing. A Silent Witness flyer will be released later this afternoon.

We are asking for any witnesses or anyone with information to please come forward.
