Arrest Made in Attempted Murder Case

(June 16, 2023) After an extensive investigation, Phoenix police detectives arrested 35-year-old Terrence Felder for the attempted murder of a man near downtown Phoenix Thursday afternoon.

On June 15, 2023, at about 1:38 p.m., a Department of Public Safety Trooper was patrolling the area of 500 West Culver Street when he was alerted to a shooting nearby. The trooper saw a man fall to the ground and another man running away. As more officers arrived, they found a man suffering from a critical gunshot wound. Phoenix Fire personnel took the man to the hospital where he is being treated for life threatening injuries.

Officers began searching the neighborhood for the outstanding suspect. Terrence Felder was located and later detained. The case was turned over to Phoenix homicide detectives who determined there was enough evidence to arrest and book Felder into the Maricopa County Jail for the attempted homicide. This remains an active and ongoing investigation.
