One of the deceased victim's last name was added. British Conception Pena.

UPDATE August 9, 2022

The age of the deceased victim Sara Loustaunau was corrected from 27 years old to 37 years old.

UPDATE August 9, 2022

The three adults killed in the crash were identified as a rideshare driver Terry Hill, passenger Sara Loustaunau, and passenger British Conception.

A passenger in the stolen vehicle died at the hospital as a result of her injuries. She was identified as Galaxy Saunders.

Investigators continue to process and review all aspects of the investigation in order to make an arrest(s).

Investigators are seeking the communities help in identifying a dark colored sedan that was racing the stolen vehicle before the crash occurred. I have attached the Silent Witness flyer.

Three Killed in Crash with Stolen Vehicle

Three people have been killed and six others injured after a stolen vehicle crashed into a car at the intersection of 43rd Avenue and Thunderbird Road in the early morning of July 22, 2022.

The stolen vehicle was going north on 43rd Avenue at an extremely high rate of speed and collided into a car that was going south, making a left turn onto Thunderbird Road. The car that was hit immediately caught fire. Three people inside, all believed to be adults, died from their injuries. There was a total of six people (teenagers and young adults) inside the stolen vehicle. All six were transported to the hospital by the fire department with serious injuries.

Investigators are working on identifying everyone involved in the crash.

This investigation remains active, and detectives are still on scene. The roadway will continue to be closed.
