OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

On June 10, 2018, at 1140 hours, officers responded to a report of an armed robbery at a business in the area of 4800 North 43rd Avenue. While fleeing in a vehicle, the suspects confronted the victim, who had been following them. One of the suspects pointed a handgun at the victim. The vehicle was located by the police helicopter as it arrived at a residence in the area of 2300 West Windrose Drive. Officers arrived on scene and attempted to make contact with the suspects but they fled into a rear residence on the property.

Officers from the Special Assignment Unit (SAU) responded and began negotiations with the suspects. After several hours, a female exited the residence and was taken into custody. She claimed there were two or three men still within the home. Officers continued negotiations but the suspects ignored their commands. Officers deployed gas into the house. A suspect inside fired shots at officers from within the residence. Officers fired suppressive shots at the residence. After additional exchanges of gunfire, a male exited the house.

Negotiations resumed but the remaining suspect/s continued to refuse to exit and peacefully surrender. When additional gas was deployed, another male suspect exited the residence and was taken into custody with the assistance of a police canine. He had in his possession rifle magazines and ammunition. The detained suspect claimed there was an additional suspect still within the home hiding and that there were additional weapons and ammunition inside. The suspect claimed the remaining suspect would not exit the home and would engage officers. Negotiations resumed, with no response from an additional suspect. Additional gas and diversionary devices were dispensed into the house. One of the officers fired additional suppressive shots. The house caught fire. SAU officers deployed fire hoses and extinguished the fire.

Searches of the residence were conducted by both SAU officers and later Fire Department personnel, but no one was located. No officers were injured during this incident. The suspect who was apprehended by the canine officer was taken to the hospital with minor injuries. He was interviewed and claimed the first male subject who exited the house was with him during the incident and that there was never a third male suspect within the home.

The first suspect has been identified as Kenny Keyes, 37 years old. He was arrested and booked for an outstanding felony arrest warrant and shoplifting. The second suspect's identity is pending the booking process. The investigation is ongoing.
