

## Officer Involved Shooting

Date/Time: July 23, 2018 at 8:47 p.m.

Suspect: Robert Zummo, male, 77 years old, Booking# T476976

On Monday, July 23, 2018, at around 7:50pm, Phoenix Police responded to the intersection of North 21st Street and East Orangewood Avenue for a call of an aggravated assault. The adult male victim reported that he was outside on the phone when the suspect, 77 year old Robert Zummo, pointed a gun at him for reasons unknown. Officers arrived and contacted the victim to begin the investigation. At around 8:45pm, officers attempted to contact the suspect who lived nearby. Initially there was no answer at the door. A short time later, the suspect emerged from his house and was holding a gun. Officers contacted the suspect who pointed the gun at police. Two officers fired their service weapons at the suspect who retreated in to the home. Minutes later, the suspect exited the home and surrendered to police. The suspect was transported to the hospital for treatment of minor injuries. He was released to police and booked into jail on three counts of Aggravated Assault on Police. There were no injuries to officers.
