RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY/OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

On December 28, 2018 at approximately 7:30 a.m., officers responded to an apartment at 5020 West Thunderbird Road on a call of a residential burglary. The caller advised that her 15 year old daughter was inside of the apartment and someone had broken in. The caller was on her way back home and she advised that her 15 year old daughter was hiding underneath the bed.

The first officer arrived on scene and was met by the caller. The officer walked into the apartment, located the 15 year old and did not locate the suspect. The second officer then arrived and assisted in the burglary investigation. The officer entered the apartment with both victims to verify what property had been taken. During this walk through the adult victim walked into the bathroom and found the suspect hiding behind the shower curtain armed with a gun. The officer entered the bathroom and confronted the suspect. The officer gave him repeated verbal commands. He ignored the commands and reached for his gun. The officer shot the suspect stopping the threat. The suspect was transported to the hospital and was pronounced deceased. There were no injuries to officers or the victims.
