The Tempe Police Department has confirmed Kenneth Hearne died yesterday from his injuries at a local hospital. The investigation remains ongoing and any further information regarding the officer involved shooting will be released by Tempe Police.

UPDATE: January 7, 2023

On January 7, 2023, members of the Special Assignments Unit conducted surveillance in the area of Lakeshore Drive and Rural Road in Tempe where Kenneth Hearne was believed to be. During the surveillance, Hearne appeared in the area. Officers moved in to arrest Hearne. Hearne displayed a firearm, and this was when the officer involved shooting occurred.

Hearne was provided aide until the fire department came on scene. Hearne was transported to the hospital where he was listed in critical condition. Tempe Police responded to investigate the officer involved shooting. The investigation remains active.

Man Wanted for Shooting Scottsdale Police Sergeant

(January 7, 2023) Phoenix police are asking for the public's help in locating 37-year-old Kenneth Hearne in connection with the shooting of an on-duty Scottdale police sergeant.

The incident occurred Friday, January 6th shortly after 7 p.m. Scottsdale Police Department's Special Assignment Unit was attempting to serve a search warrant at a Phoenix apartment complex in the area of 1st Avenue and Roosevelt Street. Immediately after shooting officers from the Phoenix Police Department assisted Scottsdale in trying to locate Hearne. They were unable to find him.

Hearne should be considered armed and dangerous and should not be approached.
