



SONORAN DESERT DRIVE & DOVE VALLEY ROAD INTERSECTION ALTERNATIVE B - T INTERSECTION

DISADVANTAGES

- Requires extensive removal of a portion of existing Dove Valley Road constructed elements
- Creates remnant parcel with an approximate size of 8 acres at the northeast corner of Sonoran Desert Drive and Dove Valley Road intersection
- Requires additional Right-of-Way footprint than Alternative A
- Requires an additional wash crossing than Alternative A

ADVANTAGES

- High driver familiarity with this type of intersection
- Separates pedestrian/bike traffic along Paseo from intersection of Sonoran Desert Drive and Dove Valley Road
- Provides full access to the new trailhead entrance

At-grade **T-intersection** providing all traffic movements located approximately 2,010 feet east of the 7th Street alignment. Full access is provided at the new trailhead entrance (under construction and scheduled to open Fall 2013). Approximately 2,600 feet (1/2 mile) of recently constructed Dove Valley Road improvements would need to be removed and two box culverts would need to be extended.
