

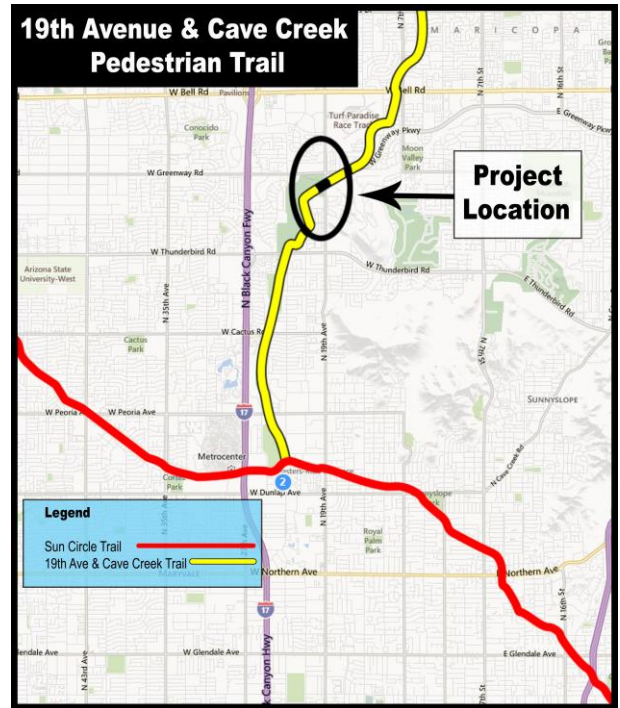


19th Avenue & Cave Creek Wash Pedestrian Trail

Cave Creek Wash Trail Information Sheet

- The Cave Creek Wash Trail is an 18-mile-long recreational trail along the Cave Creek wash with some existing gaps, including one 2,000-foot gap on the west side of 19th Avenue from the existing trail alignment to the south side of the Cave Creek Municipal Golf Course driveway.
- The purpose of this project is to connect the existing 2,000-foot gap in the Cave Creek Trail, providing better connectivity to the regional Sun Circle Trail.



- The Sun Circle Trail is a 10-foot wide trail that is ultimately planned to be a 140-mile-long multi-use path and is part of the Maricopa County Regional Trail System.



- This new asphalt trail will cross the Cave Creek Municipal Golf Course driveway, and proceed east to 19th Avenue, then north adjacent to 19th Avenue to the Cave Creek Wash Trail alignment.
- Construction of the new trail is anticipated to begin late October 2013. Overall construction is projected to last through January 2014.
- Traffic restrictions are not anticipated with the exception of some minor curb lane restrictions when work is being performed immediately adjacent to 19th Avenue.
