## ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION FOR THE WEEKS OF NOVEMBER 9 & 16, 2015

### 4TH STREET TO 5TH STREET:

The contractor has completed installation of irrigation pipe and associated lateral pipe. On Monday, November 16, crews will begin removal and replacement of the existing sidewalk and pedestrian ramps from 5th Street to 4th Street. Southwest Gas will be on site installing a utility sleeve from 5th Street to approximately 200 feet to the west.

### 5TH STREET TO 7TH STREET:

The contractor will be installing electrical conduit for new street lighting on the north side of Roosevelt Street adjacent to the Artisan Village. Some of the parking meters will be hooded, however; parking spaces will still be available.

### TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

Traffic continues to be restricted adjacent to the contractors work area, and has been redirected to the south side of Roosevelt Street beginning at 7th Street to accommodate electrical work adjacent to Artisan Village. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times. Temporary turn restrictions onto Roosevelt Street may occur.

### PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

Pedestrian access on the north side of Roosevelt Street will be redirected to the south side of the roadway between 4th and 5th Streets.
