

# Construction is Beginning !

ROOSEVELT STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT:  
4TH STREET TO 7TH STREET



## ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION FOR THE WEEKS OF NOVEMBER 30 & DECEMBER 7, 2015

### 5TH STREET:

During the week of November 30, the contractor will remove and replace the pedestrian ramps on the northeast and northwest corners of 5th and Roosevelt Streets. This work is anticipated to be completed by December 3.

### 4TH STREET:

Beginning the week of December 7, the contractor will be removing and replacing the pedestrian ramps on the northeast corner of 4th and Roosevelt Streets. The contractor will also be installing irrigation and electrical conduit sleeves.

### 5TH STREET TO 7TH STREET:

During the week of December 7, the contractor will install electrical laterals on the north side of Roosevelt Street between 5th and 7th Streets.

## TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

Traffic continues to be restricted adjacent to the contractors work area. Additional traffic restrictions will be necessary for the concrete pedestrian ramp construction at 4th Street including closure of the northbound curb lane from McKinley Street to Portland Street. The right turn onto Roosevelt Street will be maintained. And, one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times in Roosevelt Street.

## PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

Pedestrian access on the north side of Roosevelt Street will be maintained between 4th and 7th Streets, and construction activities will be buttoned up prior to the First Friday Festivities.
