Construction Starting

3rd Avenue:

On Monday, August 10, 2020, construction activities will begin at the intersection of **3rd Avenue and Latham Street**, and will include:

- Removal and replacement of existing concrete ramps, curb, gutter, sidewalk, and driveway entrance to the Japanese Friendship Garden (Garden).
- Construction of new catch basin, storm drain pipe and manhole on the northwest corner.
- New pedestrian HAWK (High-Intensity Activated Crosswalk) signal, and associated foundations, signal poles, junction boxes, and camera located at the driveway entrance into Garden and adjacent to the Great AZ Puppet Theater.
- Restoration of existing decomposed granite and turf sod in landscape areas.
- New shade structure on the south side of the driveway into the Garden, new bicycle rack on the east side of 3rd Avenue south of Latham Street, and a new Acorn Streetlight on the Northwest corner.

What to Expect:

- Work hours will generally be Monday - Friday 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Some weekend work may occur.
- Traffic restrictions will be in place including lane closures and turn restrictions.
- On-street parking may be restricted in the contractor's work area.
- Alternate routes are encouraged whenever possible.

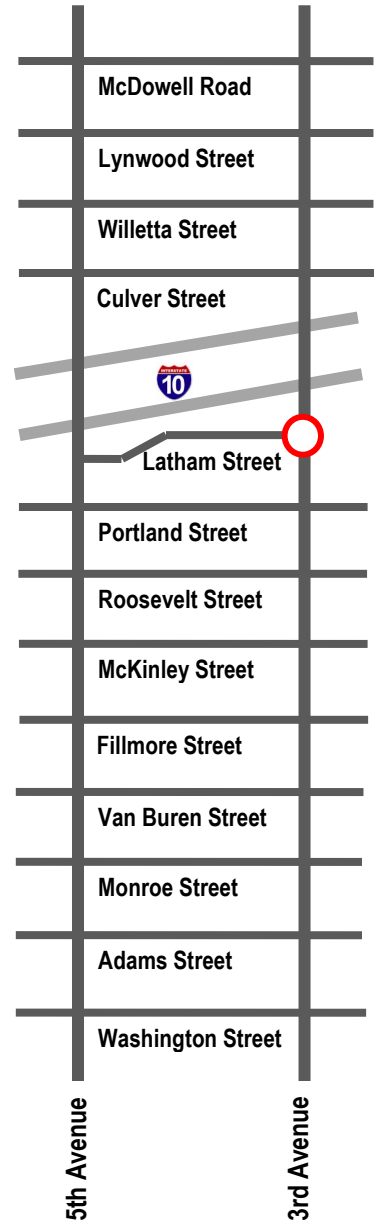
