

44th Street and Arizona Canal Crossing Project Phase I

Construction Notice

Project Overview

The city of Phoenix Street Transportation Department is set to begin construction of pedestrian traffic signal crossing improvements at 44th Street and the Arizona Canal. The purpose of this project is to increase safety for pedestrians and bicyclists who need to cross 44th Street to continue along the Arizona Canal. This project will be broken down into two phases, with Phase I beginning on **June 22, 2020** with an estimated completion date in late **July 2020**.

Construction Details

Phase I of this improvement project will include the installation of two signal poles and crosswalks on each side of the Arizona Canal in addition to the reconstruction of the sidewalk and the four canal driveway ramps.

Phase II of the project will take place in late Fall 2020 and will include a new asphalt overlay on the bridge deck.

What to Expect:

- North and southbound traffic along 44th
 Street will be reduced to one lane in each direction.
- Access to the Arizona Canal will be temporarily restricted from 40th to 48th Streets.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Please observe all signs, speed limits and lane restrictions.
