

Palm Lane Storm Drain: 28th Place to 32nd Street Project No. ST83140081

Construction Notice

The City of Phoenix Street Transportation Department is pleased to announce that the design phase of storm drain improvements for Palm Lane between 28th Place and 32nd Street is complete, and construction is anticipated to begin in August 2021. The goal of these improvements is to reduce flood hazards to neighborhood properties that have experienced historic floods. Storm drain improvements will include:

- Relocation of existing utilities including water, sewer, and gas as needed to accommodate construction of the new storm drain system.
- Removal and replacement of the existing storm drain main line, manholes, and associated lateral pipe.
- Removal and replacement of existing catch basins, curb, gutter, and sidewalk as required.
- Temporary water interruptions may occur. Impacted residents will be notified prior to any scheduled water interruptions.

What to Expect:

- Construction will begin August 16, 2021
- Work hours will generally be Monday -Friday 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (summer hours) & Monday - Friday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (winter hours). Some weekend work may occur.
- During work hours, sections of streets and driveways will be closed as required for construction.
- On-street parking will be restricted on Palm Lane.
- Alternate routes avoiding Palm Lane are encouraged whenever possible.
- Construction is expected to last approximately 6 months.
