The city of Phoenix Street Transportation Department is hosting an open house meeting to provide an update on the upcoming 24th Street and Grand Canal Bridge Project. The project is anticipated to start mid November 2019 and has an estimated completion date of late Spring 2020.

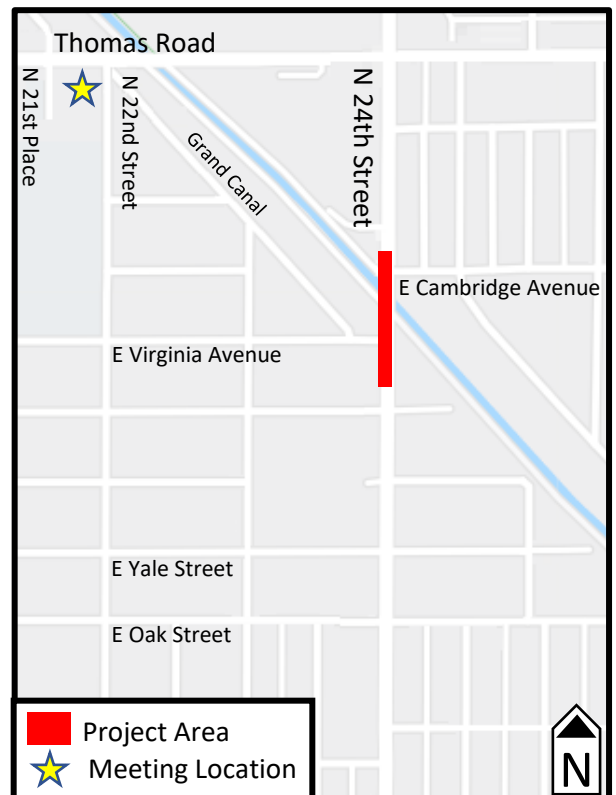
Project Details:

The contractor will install a new bridge over the existing canal. The existing bridge is more than 70 years old and is nearing the end of its useful lifespan.

What to Expect:

- Temporary closure of the Grand Canalscape multi-use trail at 24th Street.
- A full closure of 24th Street at the Grand Canal for two weeks beginning in January.
- Lane restrictions (reducing the number of travel lanes from two lanes to one lane in each direction) at times during the project.
